dimensional so that they can result in functionings in all areas of life as well as work and future study the inequalities and exclusion of the labour market and pathways to further study must be addressed by wider economic and social policies for inclusive learning outcomes to be meaningful and that universities ought to be doing more to enable black working class students to participate and succeed Low Income Students Human Development and Higher Education in South Africa makes an original contribution to capability scholarship conceptually in theorising a South based multi dimensional student well being higher education matrix and a rich reconceptualisation of learning outcomes as well as empirically by conducting rigorous longitudinal in depth mixed methods research on students lives and experiences in higher education in South Africa The audience for the book includes higher education researchers international capability scholars practitioners and policy makers
