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Africa and Black Americans

When and where does African-American history start? The answers are many, and they are not foreclosed. Moreover, black people's ideas about accurate answers have changed, as their notions of themselves, their identity, and Africa have changed. Everyone's ideas about the past reflect the concerns of the present. And as it has been with African Americans, African-American art developed alongside African as well as African-American history, both continuously reflecting black Americans' approach to Africa.

The idea of Egypt as the symbol of both ancient Africa and the origin of black Americans has enjoyed great longevity. With its classical history, huge monuments, and beautifully decorated tombs featuring people who look like African Americans, Egypt evokes black Americans with an illustrious lineage. Ancient Egypt appears here in the work of Aaron Douglas (1899–1979), the quintessential artist of the New Negro or Harlem Renaissance movement of the 1920s and 1930s (1.1). Douglas's "Building More Stately Mansions" brings together problems of what was then called Negro history over the passage of three millennia: in the background, the profile of a pharaoh; in the middle ground, ancient monuments; and in the foreground, the architecture of modern society. Douglas's evocation of ancient Egypt represents one widely accepted means of coming to terms with African Americans' origins as a people. Today African Americans pre-occupied with ancient Egypt are called "Afrocentric." Their focus has a long but intermittent history.
