Knittel, 2016-04-01 No one doubts that Gustav Mahler's tenure at the Vienna Court Opera from 1897 1907 was made extremely unpleasant by the antisemitic press The great biographer Henry Louis de La Grange acknowledges that it must be said that antisemitism was a permanent feature of Viennese life Unfortunately the focus on blatant references to Jewishness has obscured the extent to which ordinary attitudes about Jewish difference were prevalent and pervasive yet subtle and covert The context has been lost wherein such coded references to
