1. What was the relationship between the nonviolent civil rights movement and the Black Power movement in Mississippi in 1966?
 - a. These two movements had a similar end goal of Black freedom & liberation, with two completely different methods of achieving it. The claim of the Black Power movement involved the criticizing slow legislative responses from the nonviolence movement. Avoiding violence had only brought the community pain. Whenever it was attempted again, the cycle just continued to repeat. In addition to this, the results that had been produced were limited to areas of the country. True change involved intervention at the local level. The nonviolent movement saw the potential in the Black Power movement, but feared a backlash from whites. Years of nonviolence and legislation could easily be undone by one person defending themselves. The relationship was complicated, to say the least.
 - i. In my opinion, this still persists today. There seems to be a clash between the ideal of becoming someone to go back what has been taken, or to allow things to progress as we take steps for liberation. Personally, nonviolence makes the most sense, but is not always possible.
2. What caused the rise and what caused the collapse of the Black Panther Party for self-defense?
 - a. The rise of the claim to self-defense came at a time where more Afro-Americans wanted to take charge of their situation. They witnessed police brutality, and came to the call of the Black Panther Party. After arriving, they soon began openly brandishing guns where it was allowed, as a sign of strength. The United States welcomed this display, as police officers and Black Panther associates often conflicted with each other. This led to individuals both getting hurt and killed. Soon the party would dial back it's willingness for confrontation after the murders of multiple party affiliates. While the party may have been strong, they were outnumbered. This realization is what caused the rally for self-defense to die down.
3. What is cultural nationalism? Give two examples that still exist today.
 - a. Cultural nationalism is the act of having pride in one's ethnicity. It is a culmination of the embracing, improving, and furthering of a single individual group of people. When a people are oppressed, nationalism can be used to rally a community to a single cause and draw attention to it. When the race is not oppressed however, it becomes a vehement form of oppression for other races. This is due to the fact that the culture of the majority will dominate a society, as everyone is already knowledgeable of that culture. Additionally, they can witness the furthering of that ethnicity.
 - i. White Nationalism - individuals that attempt to claim "reverse discrimination". When someone attempts to realize the importance of a culture that they already dominate, it often oppresses the minorities that exist. White nationalism comes in the form of the KKK, white exclusivity, and predominantly white institutions.

Immigration and the Remaking of Black America Tod G. Hamilton, 2019-05-15 Winner of the 2020 Otis Dudley Duncan Award for Outstanding Scholarship in Social Demography Honorable Mention for the 2020 Thomas and Znaniecki Award from the International Migration Section of the American Sociological Association Over the last four decades immigration from the Caribbean and sub Saharan Africa to the U S has increased rapidly In several states African immigrants are now major drivers of growth in the black population While social scientists and commentators have noted that these black immigrants social and economic outcomes often differ from those of their native born counterparts few studies have carefully analyzed the mechanisms that produce these disparities In Immigration and the Remaking of Black America sociologist and demographer Tod Hamilton shows how immigration is reshaping black America He weaves together interdisciplinary scholarship with new data to enhance our understanding of the causes of socioeconomic stratification among both the native born and newcomers Hamilton demonstrates that immigration from the Caribbean and sub Saharan Africa is driven by selective migration meaning that newcomers from these countries tend to have higher educational attainment than those who stay behind As a result they arrive in the U S with some advantages over native born blacks and in some cases over whites He also shows the importance of historical context prior to

the Civil Rights Movement black immigrants socioeconomic outcomes resembled native born blacks much more closely regardless of their educational attainment in their country of origin Today however certain groups of black immigrants have better outcomes than native born black Americans such as lower unemployment rates and higher rates of homeownership in part because they immigrated at a time of expanding opportunities for minorities and women in general Hamilton further finds that rates of marriage and labor force participation among native born blacks that move away from their birth states resemble those of many black immigrants suggesting that some disparities within the black population stem from processes associated with migration rather than from nativity alone Hamilton argues that failing to account for this diversity among the black population can lead to incorrect estimates of the social progress made by black Americans and the persistence of racism and discrimination He calls for future research on racial inequality to disaggregate different black populations By richly detailing the changing nature of black America Immigration and the Remaking of Black America helps scholars and policymakers to better understand the complexity of racial disparities in the twenty first century
