present situation in Iraq The conflict itself can range from acts of terrorism to the more conventional use of the media to sway public opinion Whatever form the insurgency takes it serves an ideology or political goal What are the root causes of an insurgency For an insurgency to flourish a majority of the population must either support or remain indifferent to insurgent ideals and practices There must be a powerful reason that drives a portion of the populace to armed opposition against the existing government Grievances may have a number of causes such the lack of economic opportunity restrictions on basic liberties government corruption ethnic or religious tensions or the presence of an occupying force It is through this line of thought or ideal that insurgents attempt to mobilize the population Understanding Counterinsurgency What is counterinsurgency DOD defines counterinsurgency as those military paramilitary political economic psychological and civic actions taken by a government to defeat insurgency Also called COIN The United States uses a wide breadth of national capabilities to defeat insurgencies through a variety of means The Department of State DOS Central Intelligence Agency CIA and Department of Justice DOJ use country teams to generate strategic objectives and assist the host nation government The military may support those efforts by employing conventional forces in combination with Special Operations Forces SOF in a variety of activities aimed at enhancing security and or alleviating causes of unrest The Marines, Counterinsurgency, and Strategic Culture Jeannie L. Johnson,2018 The US Marine Corps has traditionally been one of the most innovative branches of the US military but even it has struggled to learn and retain lessons from past counterinsurgency wars Jeannie L Johnson looks at the clash between strategic culture and organizational learning through the US Marine Corps s long experience with counterinsurgency She first undertakes a fascinating examination of what makes the Marines distinct their identity norms values and perceptual lens To do this Johnson uses an innovative framework for analyzing strategic culture Next she traces the history of the Marines counterinsurgency experience from the expeditionary missions of the early twentieth century through the Vietnam War and finally to the Iraq War She shows that even a service as self aware and dedicated to innovation as the US Marine Corps is significantly constrained in the lessons learned process by its own internal predispositions Even when internal preferences can be changed ingrained biases endemic to the broader US military culture and American public culture create barriers to learning *Department of Defense Authorization for Appropriations for Fiscal Year 2008* United States. Schlosser,2015 U S Marines in Irregular Warfare Training and Education is a brief history that recounts how the U S Marine Corps adapted to fight the Global War on Terrorism during 2000 10 The Marine Corps has a long history of fighting irregular wars including the Banana Wars in Central America during the 1920s and the Vietnam War during the 1960s To battle the insurgencies in Iraq and Afghanistan the Corps drew upon this experience while also implementing new plans and programs to better prepare Marines to carry out counterinsurgency operations The Marine Corps updated the curriculum at the Command and Staff College and transformed the annual Combined Arms Exercise into Exercise Mojave Viper an immersive

training program that simulated the urban environments in which Marines would be operating in Southwest Asia. Most importantly, Marines adjusted in the field as battalion and company commanders drew on their basic training and education to devise innovative tactics to better combat the new threats they now faced. As this story shows, the Marine Corps did not undergo a radical transformation to fight in Iraq and Afghanistan but instead drew on principles that had defined it as a warfighting organization throughout most of its history.

For the past decade, the U.S. Marine Corps and its sister services have been engaged in what has been termed hybrid warfare, which ranges from active combat to civilian support.
