

World Religion Study Guide:

Judaism:

Yom Kippur: Day of Atonement.

Torah: The law, given on Mount Sinai from God through Moses to the people of Israel. **Talmud:** Commentary on the commentary on the Law.

Second Temple: Center of Jewish worship until its destruction in 70 A.D.

Diaspora: Dispersion of the Jewish people outside of the promised land.

Mishnah: Commentary on the Law.

Shema: Fundamental Jewish prayer that affirms the oneness and lordship of God.

Rosh Hashanah: Jewish New Year.

Halakhah: Legal prescriptions for daily life.

Aggadah: Narrative, non-legal texts that illustrate and help illuminate the

halakhah. **Midrash:** Commentary on *halakhah* and *Aggadah*.

The Sabbath: Jews rest from all work on Saturday, the Seventh Day of the Week; mimicking God, who rested on the 7th Day of Creation.

Sukkoth: Commemoration of the 40 years wandering the desert after the Exodus from Egypt. **Pesach (Passover):** A weeklong commemoration of the liberation from slavery in Egypt.
