Frank Baum, 2017-09-11 The Marvelous Land of Oz is the second book in Baum s Oz series The series chronicles the further adventures of Dorothy both in and out of Oz as she deals with the characters situations and desires which continue to spill over from her first fateful adventure Tip and his creation Jack Pumpkin run away to Oz where they save the city after it is captured by girls Lyman Frank Baum was an American author actor and independent filmmaker best known as the creator along with illustrator W W Denslow of one of the most popular books in American children s literature The Wonderful Wizard of Oz better known today as simply The Wizard of Oz Born in Chittenango New York into a Protestant family of German origin he was the seventh of nine children born to Cynthia Stanton and Benjamin Ward Baum only five of whom survived into adulthood He was named Lyman after his father s brother but always disliked the name and preferred to go by Frank Frank started writing at an early age perhaps due to an early fascination with printing When his father bought him a cheap printing press he used it to produce The Rose Lawn Home Journal with the help of his younger brother Harry Then in 1897 he wrote and published Mother Goose in Prose illustrated by Maxfield Parrish Mother Goose was a moderate success and allowed Baum to quit his day job In 1900 Baum and Denslow published The Wonderful Wizard of Oz to much critical and financial acclaim the book went on to become the bestselling children s book for two years after its initial publication and the legacy was born
