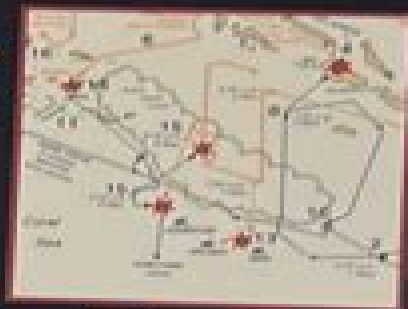

Symonds, 2006-10-23 From thunderous broadsides traded between wooden sailing ships on Lake Erie to the carrier battles of World War II to the devastating high tech action in the Persian Gulf here is a gripping history of five key battles that defined the evolution of naval warfare and the course of the American nation Acclaimed military historian Craig Symonds offers spellbinding narratives of crucial engagements showing how each battle reveals the transformation of technology and weaponry from one war to the next how these in turn transformed naval combat and how each event marked a milestone in American history Oliver Hazard Perry s heroic victory at Lake Erie one of the last great battles of the Age of Sail which secured the Northwestern frontier for the United States The brutal Civil War duel between the ironclads Monitor and Virginia which sounded the death knell for wooden hulled warships and doomed the Confederacy s hope of besting the Union navy Commodore Dewey s stunning triumph at Manila Bay in 1898 where the U S displayed its new navy of steel hulled ships firing explosive shells and wrested an empire from a fading European power The hairsbreadth American victory at Midway where aircraft carriers launched planes against enemies 200 miles away and where the tide of World War II turned in the space of a few furious minutes Operation Praying Mantis in the Persian Gulf where computers ship fired missiles and smart bombs not only changed the nature of warfare at sea but also marked a new era and a new responsibility for the United States Symonds records these encounters in detail so vivid that readers can hear the wind in the rigging and feel the pounding of the guns Yet he places every battle in a wide perspective revealing their significance to America s development as it grew from a new Republic on the edge of a threatening frontier to a global superpower

Silversides Drum and Tang The War Below vividly re creates the camaraderie exhilaration and fear of the brave volunteers who took the fight to the enemy s coastline in World War II Award winning journalist James Scott recounts incredible feats of courage from an emergency appendectomy performed with kitchen utensils to sailors desperate struggle to escape from a flooded submarine as well as moments of unimaginable tragedy including an attack on an unmarked enemy freighter carrying 1 800 American prisoners of war The casualty rate among submariners topped that of all other military branches The war claimed almost one out of every five submarines and a submarine crewman was six times more likely to die than a sailor onboard a surface ship But this valorous service accomplished its mission Silversides Drum and Tang sank a combined sixty two freighters tankers and transports The Japanese were so ravaged from the loss of precious supplies that by the war s end pilots resorted to suicidal kamikaze missions and hungry civilians ate sawdust while warships had to drop anchor due to lack of fuel In retaliation the Japanese often beat tortured and starved captured submariners in the atrocious prisoner of war camps Based on more than 100 interviews with submarine veterans and thousands of pages of previously unpublished letters and diaries The War Below lets readers experience the battle for the Pacific as never before

McPherson, 2012-09-17 Although previously undervalued for their strategic impact because they represented only a small percentage of total forces the Union and Confederate navies were crucial to the outcome of the Civil War In War on the Waters James M McPherson has crafted an enlightening at times harrowing and ultimately thrilling account of the war s naval campaigns and their military leaders McPherson recounts how the Union navy s blockade of the Confederate coast leaky as a sieve in the war s early months became increasingly effective as it choked off vital imports and exports Meanwhile the Confederate navy dwarfed by its giant adversary demonstrated daring and military innovation Commerce raiders sank Union ships and drove the American merchant marine from the high seas Southern ironclads sent several Union warships to the bottom naval mines sank many more and the Confederates deployed the world s first submarine to sink an enemy vessel But in the end it was the Union navy that won some of the war s most important strategic victories as an essential partner to the army on the ground at Fort Donelson Vicksburg Port Hudson Mobile Bay and Fort Fisher and all by itself at Port Royal Fort Henry New Orleans and Memphis

Cotham, 2009-09-15 The confiscated Yankee diary that ran in the Confederate press fully annotated and illustrated with drawings by a fellow Civil War Marine On September 28 1863 the Galveston Tri Weekly News included an item headlined A Yankee Note Book It was the first installment of a diary confiscated from U S Marine Henry O Gusley who had been captured at the Battle of Sabine Pass It was so popular the newspaper made an ongoing series of the entire diary running each excerpt twice For Confederate readers Gusley s diary provided a rare glimpse into the opinions and feelings of an ordinary Yankee an enemy whom they quickly discovered it would be easy to regard as a friend This book contains the complete text of Henry Gusley s Civil War diary expertly annotated and introduced by Edward Cotham One of the few surviving journals by a U S Marine serving along the Gulf Coast it records some of the most important naval campaigns of the Civil War including the spectacular Union success at New Orleans and the embarrassing defeats at Galveston and Sabine Pass It also offers an unmatched portrait of life aboard ship It also includes previously unpublished drawings by Daniel Nestell a doctor who served alongside Gusley
