2 Dr Fuchs deals primarily with severe forms of dysfunctional behavior categorized as mental disorders, pinpointing those genetically based behavioral complexes which predispose humans to anxiety, affective and personality disorders, paranoia and schizophrenia.

3 Dr Fuchs also makes clear that the above innate predispositions cannot lead by themselves to the whole clinical picture of diagnosable mental disorder categories. In order for full-blown clinical symptomatology to develop, the innate predisposition has to interact with influences after childbirth. First of all, learning. Consequently, psychiatric understanding and research has to distinguish sharply between those mental brain structures and functions which constitute the innate predisposition to a certain mental disorder versus those ones involved secondarily during the lifespan. This consideration is detailed in the case of schizophrenia spectrum of disorders. The above theoretical considerations have important therapeutic, preventive and research implications.
