structures changes in compensation for employees of financial companies as compared to compensation for others with similar skill sets in the labor market the legal and regulatory structure of the United States housing market derivatives and unregulated financial products and practices including credit default swaps short selling financial institution reliance on numerical models including risk models and credit ratings the legal and regulatory structure governing financial institutions including the extent to which the structure creates the opportunity for financial institutions to engage in regulatory arbitrage the legal and regulatory structure governing investor and mortgagor protection financial institutions and government sponsored enterprises and the quality of due diligence undertaken by financial institutions The Commission is called upon to examine the causes of major financial institutions which failed or were likely to have failed had they not received exceptional government assistance In its work the Commission is authorized to hold hearings issue subpoenas either for witness testimony or documents and refer to the Attorney General or the appropriate state Attorney General any person who may have violated U S law in relation to the financial crisis
