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U.S. Women's History Leslie Brown, Jacqueline Castledine, Anne Valk, 2017-01-25 In the 1970s feminist slogans proclaimed Sisterhood is powerful and women's historians searched through the historical archives to recover stories of solidarity and sisterhood. James Bennett, 2019-11-20 *Intercollegiate Athletics, Inc.* examines the corrupting influence and damaging financial effects of big-time intercollegiate athletics, especially football, and to a lesser extent basketball, on American higher education. Including historical and contemporary perspectives, the book traces the growth of intercollegiate sports from largely student-run activities supervised by faculty to the gargantuan taxpayer-supported spectacles that now dominate many public universities. It investigates the regressive student fees that have helped subsidize big-time sports at public universities and prop up chronically unprofitable athletic departments, as well as the corrosive effects of athletics on the university's academic enterprise. A review of the alleged salutary effects of massive sports programs, such as spurring alumni donations and student applications, reveals that such benefits are largely illusory, more myth than real. The book also pays special attention to the often prescient if largely unsuccessful opponents of these developments and considers the alternatives to big-time athletics, from abolition to professionalization to club sports. Students, scholars, sports fans, and those interested in learning how big-time football and basketball have cast such an enormous and often baleful shadow upon American colleges and universities will profit from this provocative and engagingly written book.

Spell Freedom Elaine Weiss, 2025-03-04 The acclaimed author of the stirring definitive and engrossing NPR *The Woman's Hour* returns with the story of four activists whose audacious plan to restore voting rights to Black Americans laid the groundwork for the Civil Rights Movement. In the summer of 1954, educator Septima Clark and small businessman Esau Jenkins travelled to rural Tennessee's Highlander Folk School, an interracial training center for social change founded by Myles Horton, a white southerner with roots in the labor movement. There, the trio united behind a shared mission, preparing

Black southerners to pass the daunting Jim Crow era voter registration literacy tests that were designed to disenfranchise them Together with beautician turned teacher Bernice Robinson they launched the underground Citizenship Schools project which began with a single makeshift classroom hidden in the back of a rural grocery store By the time the Voting Rights Act was signed into law in 1965 the secretive undertaking had established more than nine hundred citizenship schools across the South preparing tens of thousands of Black citizens to read and write demand their rights and vote Simultaneously it nurtured a generation of activists many of them women trained in community organizing political citizenship and tactics of resistance and struggle who became the grassroots foundation of the Civil Rights Movement Dr King called Septima Clark Mother of the Movement In the vein of Hidden Figures and Devil in the Grove Spell Freedom is both a riveting crucially important lens onto our past and a deeply moving story for our present *The Georgia of the North* Hettie V.

Williams,2024-07-12 The Georgia of the North is a historical narrative about Black women and the long civil rights movement in New Jersey from the Great Migration to 1954 Specifically the critical role played by Black women in forging interracial cross class and cross gender alliances at the local and national level and their role in securing the passage of progressive civil rights legislation in the Garden State is at the core of this book This narrative is largely defined by a central question How and why did New Jersey s Black leaders community members and women in particular affect major civil rights legislation legal equality and integration a decade before the Brown v Board of Education Topeka Kansas decision In this analysis the history of the early Black freedom struggle in New Jersey is predicated on the argument that the Civil Rights Movement began in New Jersey and that Black women were central actors in this struggle **Harold Garfinkel** Michael

Crescent City Girls LaKisha Michelle Simmons,2015-05-28 What was it like to grow up black and female in the segregated South To answer this question LaKisha Simmons blends social history and cultural studies recreating children s streets and neighborhoods within Jim Crow New Orleans and offering a rare look into black girls personal lives Simmons argues that these children faced the difficult task of adhering to middle class expectations of purity and respectability even as they encountered the daily realities of Jim Crow violence which included interracial sexual aggression street harassment and presumptions of black girls impurity Simmons makes use of oral histories the black and white press social workers reports police reports girls fiction writing and photography to tell the stories of individual girls some from poor working class families some from middle class respectable families and some caught in the Jim Crow judicial system These voices come together to create a group biography of ordinary girls living in an extraordinary time girls who did
