Une intrigue criminelle de la philosophie Jean-Clet Martin, 2015-03-05 Lire l'austère Hegel comme un polar pour mieux le comprendre C'est tout l'enjeu de ce livre original en quete d'intrigues de personnages inquiétants de criminels de bruit et de fureur pour refaire enfin de Hegel notre contemporain La doctrine de Hegel a la réputation d'être obscure Sa philosophie suit le sens d'une histoire racontée très difficile de la pensée démonstrative qui ne saisit guère les aventures d'un concept Hegel sera le premier mettre en haleine le mouvement de toute pensée lui conférant ainsi le sens d'une Histoire qui comporte différentes scènes souvent meurtrises partir de la défense d'un criminel Hegel a montré que la philosophie est toujours une pensée très concrète tandis que l'abstraction et la précipitation sont du côté de l'opinion populaire du jugement de la foule Ce sont des images parfois funestes que l'auteur a privilégiées agressivité de l'animal violence du maître outrages de Bacchus mort d'Antigone celle d'un roi meurtrier de Dieu ou mort de l'homme Pour Hegel toute création conceptuelle se traduit par un crime elle se nourrit du corps de son ennemi comme une araignée s'enrichissant jusqu'à ce qu'elle ait arraché toute la substance la conscience suçotant tout l'édifice de ses essentialités Cette intrigue l'auteur la suit en sa richesse poustouflante réintégrant Hegel l'intérieur de la philosophie contemporaine qui l'a injustement refoulé au profit de Nietzsche dont pourtant il permet de renouveler l'approche Cette lecture nouvelle et intégrale de la Philosophie de l'Esprit montre un Hegel penseur du nihilisme de la mort de Dieu et de l'homme submergé par sa foi naïve dans l'économie capitaliste naissante

Une intrigue criminelle de philosophie Jean-Clet Martin, 2009 **Hegel and Deleuze** Karen Houle, Jim Vernon, 2013-06-30 Hegel and Deleuze cannily examines the various resonances and dissonances between these two major philosophers The collection represents the best in contemporary international scholarship on G W F Hegel and Gilles Deleuze and the contributing authors inhabit the as yet uncharted space between the two thinkers collectively addressing most of the major tensions and resonances between their ideas and laying a solid ground for future scholarship The essays are organized thematically into two groups those that maintain a firm but nuanced disjunction or opposition between Hegel and Deleuze and those that chart possible connections syntheses or both As is clear from this range of texts the challenges involved in grasping appraising appropriating and developing the systems of Deleuze and Hegel are varied and immense While neither Hegel nor Deleuze gets the last word the contributors ably demonstrate that partisans of either can no longer ignore the voice of the other

Transgression and the Inexistent Mehdi Belhaj

Kacem, 2014-10-23 A contemporary philosopher of Tunisian origin Mehdi Belhaj Kacem is here published in English for the first time His new book *Transgression and the Inexistent A Philosophical Vocabulary* is a comprehensive foray into Kacem's elaborate philosophical system in twenty seven discreet chapters each dedicated to a single concept In each chapter he explicates a critical re thinking of ordinary lived experiences such as desire irony play or traditional philosophical ideas such as catharsis mimesis techne in light of the spirit of nihilism that marks the contemporary human condition Kacem gained notoriety in the domain of critical theory amid his controversial break with his mentor and leading contemporary philosopher Alain Badiou *Transgression and the Inexistent* lays out the essential concepts of his philosophical system it is the most complete and synthetic book of his philosophical work as well as being one of the most provocative in its claims As a Francophone author engaging with contemporary world thought he is able to develop novel philosophical perspectives that reach beyond the Middle East or the Continental and the East West binary This is the book's first publication in any language constituting a much awaited first translation of Kacem into English

Subject Matter Aron Vinegar, 2023-11-28 A theorization of habit that emphasizes its excessive and unsettling qualities rather than its mediating adaptive and stabilizing functions *Subject Matter* offers a bold counterpoint to prevalent conceptions of habit characterized by bodily fluidity and ease as the stabilizing foundation of an emerging subjectivity or more negatively as a numbing and deadening force Instead of facilitating the coordination of action with goal and self with environment habit appears here as a disruptively recursive operation with extreme ontological implications that are often more quotidian than exceptional Vinegar theorizes habit's more perturbing aspects from repetition compulsion to kenosis to breakdown through an encounter between Hegel's philosophy of habit psychoanalytic dimensions of repetition Tom McCarthy's novel *Remainder* and Omer Fast's feature length film interpretation of the novel Vinegar starts with the premise that habit is an unhappy mediator a disturbance of the very medium and milieu that is constitutive of the subject *Subject Matter* pays close attention to those aspects of habit that are usually considered deviations from or potential threats to habit proper and that generate a logic of breakdown automaticity mechanization thingness inertia and fixity By plotting a topology of habit's unbearability through detailed accounts of its manifestation in writing art aesthetics and viscosity and through an attentiveness to the unbalanced nonrelations between mediation and immediacy being and having fixity and fluidity vanishing and overflowing abbreviation and excess beginning and ending Vinegar exposes habit's failure to mediate and inhabit In doing so he offers new and counterintuitive insights into how habit generates the unruly grounds it is supposed to settle thus allowing us to ask how we might break down differently

DERRIDA : Le démantèlement de l'Occident Jean-Clet Martin, 2013-10-17 La déconstruction est le concept qui a rendu mondialement célèbre Derrida Mais personne encore n'a exploré suffisamment cette stratégie de déconstruction fragmentaire plus que monumentale Pour la première fois Jean Clet Martin en offre une lecture intégrale Il suit le cheminement de Derrida tendu vers le lointain l'ailleurs pratiquant une véritable expérience de la différence S'y affirme une

autre vision de l'homme de la femme de la sexualité de l'ami de l'animal L'Occident n'a jamais su penser l'Autre refusant de concevoir la différence laquelle notre économie impose l'identité d'une pensée unique Mais penser vraiment c'est entrer dans une confrontation dans une différence radicale au risque de se perdre Penser avec justice nous entraîne sur une limite qui n'est pas celle de l'homme blanc majoritaire lui qui consomme tous les vivants et détruit ce qui apparaît comme étranger D'où le besoin urgent de créer des mots nouveaux d'aller voir ce qui circule dans la marge hors de l'Occident mais encore dans les folies de l'art si souvent incomprises La déconstruction apparaît alors en un dépaysement qui fait de Derrida comme un Peau Rouge ou un marrane solitaire Jean Clet Martin est philosophe Traduit au Japon et aux États-Unis il a successivement publié des ouvrages sur Deleuze Payot Borges L'écrit ou encore sur la peinture de Van Gogh Le Seuil Il a créé le site Strass de la philosophie
