The Spirit, New Creation, and Christian Identity Grant Buchanan, 2023-05-18 Considering the importance of pneumatological themes for interpreting Paul's argument of Galatians Grant Buchanan explores how Paul draws from Jewish traditions of creation and the Spirit and presents a fresh cosmogony to the Galatian church He suggests that Galatians outlines an epistemological shift in how Paul sees past present and future reality in light of Christ and the presence of the Spirit in the lives of the believers The most crucial aspect of this new cosmogony is the centrality of the Spirit in Paul's argument in Galatians 3:1-6:17 with Buchanan's exegesis revealing that the Spirit the Galatians' identity as children of God and the new creation motif are not merely elements of Paul's argument but intrinsic to it Buchanan demonstrates that Paul renders Jewish and Gentile identities no longer valid instead revealing that God's favour and election is already with them by stating that those who have the promised Spirit are all children of God He examines Jewish biblical and Second Temple extra biblical texts that explicitly connect the Spirit to creation themes including Genesis Ezekiel the Dead Sea Scrolls and the Wisdom of Solomon Taking Galatians 6:11-17 as the body closing of the letter the new creation motif directly implies the activity of the Spirit in the creation of Christian identity Analysing 6:15 from this pneumatological perspective Buchanan argues that the new creation motif represents a key aspect of Paul's generative cosmogony and pneumatology indicating a far broader socio cosmic transformation than previously assumed and it becomes a key to understanding Paul's argument

This volume offers a comprehensive examination of circumcision and foreskin in the undisputed Pauline epistles. Historically, Paul's discourse on circumcision has been read through the lens of Paul's supposed abandonment of Judaism and conversion to Christianity. Recent scholarship on Paul, however, has challenged the idea that Paul ever abandoned Judaism. In the context of this revisionist reading of Paul, Ryan Collman argues that Paul never repudiates, redefines, or replaces circumcision. Rather, Paul's discourse on circumcision and foreskin is shaped by his understanding of ethnicity and his bifurcation of humanity into the categories of Jews and the nations: the circumcision and the foreskin. Collman argues that Paul does not deny the continuing validity and importance of circumcision for Jewish followers of Jesus, but categorically refuses that gentile believers can undergo circumcision. By reading this language in its historical, rhetorical, epistolary, and ethnic contexts, Collman offers a number of new readings of difficult Pauline texts, e.g., Rom 4:9-12, Gal 5:1-4, Phil 3:2-3.

In the dominant interpretation of the Antioch incident Paul is viewed as separating from Peter and Jewish Christianity to lead his own independent mission which was eventually to triumph in the creation of a church with a gentile identity Paul s gentile mission however represented only one strand of the Christ movement but has been universalized to signify the whole The consequence of this view of Paul is that the earliest diversity in which he operated and which he affirmed has been anachronistically diminished almost to the point of obliteration There is little recognition of the Jewish form of Christianity and that Paul by and large related positively to it as evidenced in Romans 14 15 Here Paul acknowledges Jewish identity as an abiding reality rather than as a temporary and weak form of faith in Christ This book argues that diversity in Christ was fundamental to Paul and that particularly in his ethical guidance this received recognition Paul s relation to Judaism is best understood not as a reaction to his former faith but as a transformation resulting from his vision of Christ In this the past is not obliterated but transformed and thus continuity is maintained so that the identity of Christianity is neither that of a new religion nor of a Jesus cult In Christ the past is reconfigured and thus the diversity of humanity continues within the church which can celebrate the richness of differing identities under the Lordship of Christ
