Sperberg-McQueen, 2020-05-01 This study reassesses the poetry of Paul Fleming 1609 1640 in the context of its own literary historical and social background The four chapters focus initially on generic and historical context The study of selected texts leads to more general considerations of the sources and significance of certain major themes A number of poems by Fleming and poets contemporary with him uncovered in the twentieth century are evaluated here for the first time The result is a substantially revised view of Fleming's poetic development Fleming is shown to have been a more complex and wide ranging poet than was conventionally thought one whose debt to Renaissance literary traditions has been underestimated
