A summary is a shortened version of a longer reading that tells the basic ideas of the reading.

Be sure to:

- Keep your summary short (3 – 5 sentences)
- Write about the main ideas
- Use both your words AND key words from the text

W

wanted

What does the main character want?

B

but

What is the problem?

How does the character try to solve the problem?
