However, she did not cook before and did not know how to approach the matter, and the amount of information she found online was overwhelming.

I think with this conversation, and I made a difference because I choose to actively listen to the complaints and fears that M. A. had instead of dismissing them and telling her to find information online or follow the advice she was already given. In general, the conversation went well because my main goal was to help M. A. by further explaining her
