The "Hamburger essay" pattern helps you get a clear structure for your essay.

Paragraph 1: INTRODUCTION

- Try to grab the reader's attention
- Present general information about your topic
- State the issue you are going to discuss

Paragraph 2: BODY (first point)

- Present the first point
- Give details and examples to support your point (arguments for or against)

Paragraph 3: BODY (second point)

- · Present the second point
- Give details and examples to support your point (arguments for or against)

Paragraph 4: BODY (third point)

- Present the third point
- Give details and examples to support your point (arguments for or against)

Paragraph 5: CONLUSION

- Sum up the main message of the essay
- Write a sentence or two that will leave your reader thinking about your topic
