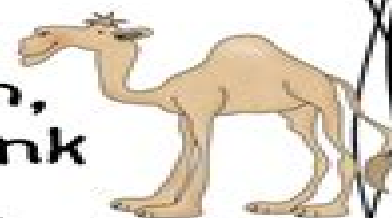


Animal Homes
