Frog Day

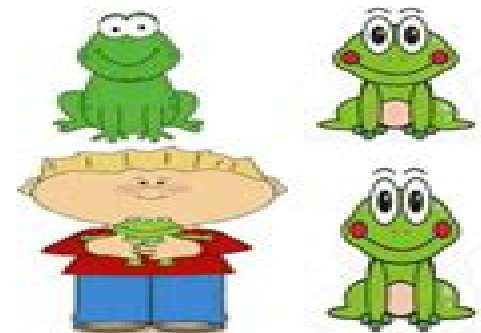
