

CONCLUDING SENTENCE

Definition:

A concluding sentence summarizes the main point of a paragraph or essay, wrapping up the discussion succinctly.

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Conclusion

The conclusion is an aspect of the body of focus on the outcome of the argumentation. It constitutes the last 10% of a paper and consists of two sections: the summary and the final thought.

Because the reader's final impression will influence his or her perception of the rest of the paper, the conclusion is your chance to reaffirm your position in a convincing way.

Summary

The conclusion's first task is to summarize the arguments that were presented in the body of the paper by focusing on the connections between the main ideas and the thesis. All the central conclusions that have been made must be restated in a new, efficient and coherent way in order to convince the reader of their validity.

A strong summary reaffirms the thesis and highlights the strength of the paper. Only the most compelling ideas should be selected. Do not introduce new arguments like "The reader cannot think this paper is that good in this sense."

Final thought

The conclusion's second task is to make a final comment that supports the thesis in a memorable way. The closing line of a paper must function since the thesis in a larger context by showing its significance within the field of study.

Here are a few ways of ending the paper:

Answer a question that was asked in the introduction

We came to find industrial expansion more important than environmental issues not simply because of self-interest, but because of short-sightedness as well. Instead, it is partly because we do not bother to think of long-term consequences that we destroy such important resources.

Endorse your position with a relevant image

Instead of a sentence that ends with the tagline, a vast pile of rolling new designs and even new colors. This is the immediate effect of the introduction of the red velvet sweater. It has already begun, through clear rolling patterns and colorful beaded illustrations, and it has to stop before it is too late.

Make a prediction or propose a solution

In order to save the introduced seedlings, we must halt the destruction of its habitats and provide compensation for the challenges of climate. If we do not act quickly, there will soon be no seedlings left to speak of, and the introduction of the area will be even worse off than before the introduction of logging practices.
