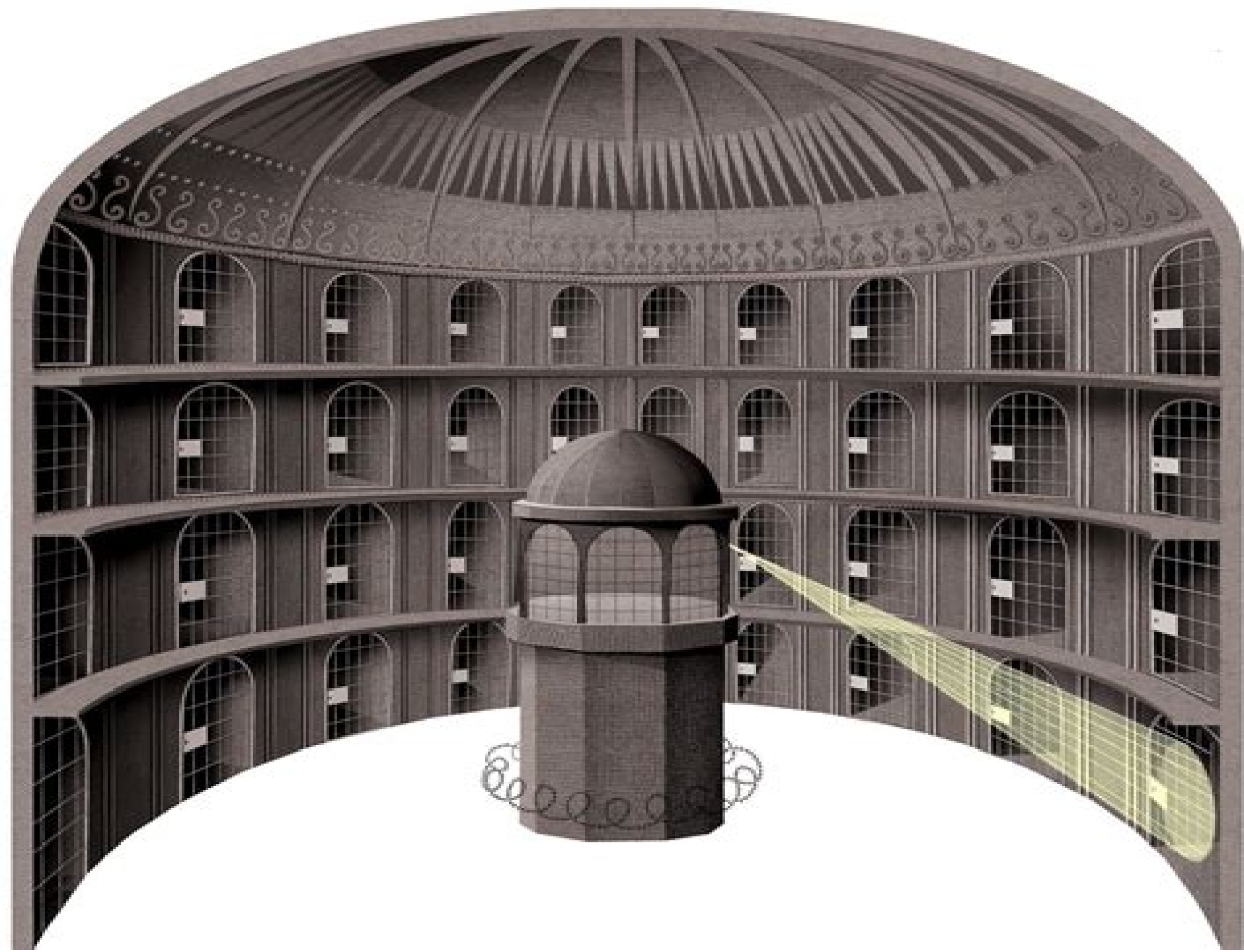

*Conspiracy, Revolution, and Terrorism from Victorian Fiction to the Modern Novel* Adrian S.
