

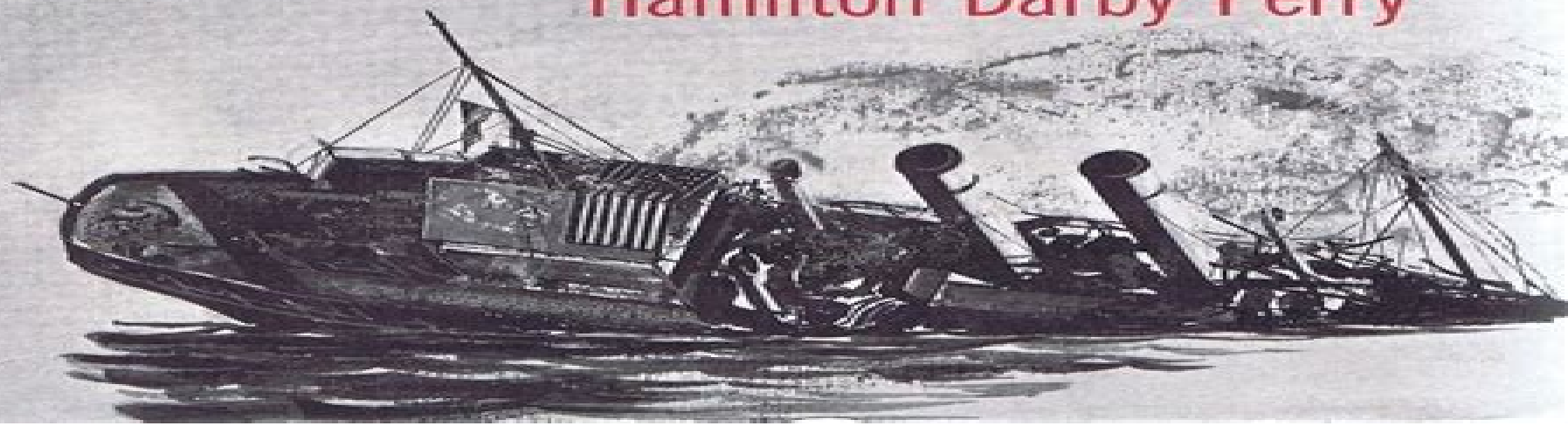

Beede, 2012-08-06 The Small Wars of the United States 1899 2009 is the complete bibliography of works on US military intervention and irregular warfare around the world as well as efforts to quell insurgencies on behalf of American allies The text covers conflicts from 1898 to present with detailed annotations of selected sources In this second edition Benjamin R Beede revises his seminal work bringing it completely up to date including entries on the current conflicts in Iraq and Afghanistan An invaluable research tool The Small Wars of the United States 1899 2009 is a critical resource for students and scholars studying US military history Iris Chang, 2012-01 Relates an account of the 1937 massacre of 250 000 Chinese civilians in Nanking by the invading Japanese military a carnage for which the Japanese government has never admitted responsibility *Dorwart's History of the Office of Naval Intelligence, 1865-1945* Jeffery Dorwart, 2019-10-01 This is the history of the founding in 1882 and operation through two world wars of America s first permanent intelligence agency the Office of Naval Intelligence In this study Dr Jeffery M Dorwart shows how and why a tiny late 19th century U S Navy bureau created to collect information about foreign warship design became during two world wars a complex and sometimes troubled domestic and worldwide intelligence agency More significantly this history of O N I demonstrates how the founders and first generations of U S naval officers trained to man warships at sea confronted what seemed an inherent dilemma in new missions that interfered with providing technical and operational information to their navy Dorwart explains the forces that created this dilemma and how ONI officers responded in different ways to their intelligence mission This history recounts how from the very beginning ONI duty during the last decades of the 19th century seemed conflicting Some found the new assignment very rewarding in collecting and collating data for the U S to build a New Navy of steel and steam powered warships armed with the latest rifled ordnance But other naval officers saw assignment to this tiny office as a monotonous dead end assignment endangering their careers as shipboard operators Dorwart shows how the first and second world wars and interwar period dramatically accelerated the naval intelligence office s dilemma The threats in both oceans from powerful enemy navies equipped with the latest technology and weaponry gave an urgency to the collection of information on the strategies warships submarines and aircraft development of potential and actual naval enemies But at the same time ONI was asked to provide information of possible domestic threats from suspected enemy spies terrorists saboteurs or anti war opponents This led ONI officers to wiretap break and enter pursue surveillance of all types of people

from foreign agents to Americans suspected of opposition to strengthening the U S Navy or becoming involved in world wars This history explains that many ONI directors and officers were highly motivated to collect as much information as possible about the naval military capabilities and strategies of Germany Italy Japan and even allies ONI officers understood that code breaking was part of their job as well But this all led some to become deeply involved in domestic spying wiretapping breaking and entering on private property These extralegal and at times illegal operations Dorwart argues confused some ONI officers leading to too much information that clouded vital intelligence such as Japanese plans to attack American naval bases In the end this study demonstrates the dilemma confronted between 1882 and 1945 by dedicated U S naval officers attached to or collecting information worldwide for the Office of Naval Intelligence

Martin, 2011 OUT OR WAR TORN SKIES A LEGENDARY PILOT IS BORN Royal Leonard 1905 1962 flew in and out of aviation history just on the edge of fame His exploits mirror important developments in the Golden Age of American Aviation 1925 1941 and the Sino Japanese War 1937 1945 If Royal's story were told in a novel says long time China pilot and author Felix Smith nobody would believe it all could have happened to one man Royal learned his craft at the West Point of the Air in San Antonio Texas As a Western Air Express night mail pilot he pioneered blind flying along the treacherous Rocky Mountains As a TWA pilot he introduced celestial navigation An early Airline Pilots Association ALPA officer he fought for mail plane safety at the cost of his job He flew the Lockheed Orion in which Wiley Post and Will Rogers later crashed and attributed their fatal accident to a surprising cause During the 1930s a handful of elite pilots were racers Jackie Cochran selected Royal as a copilot for the MacRobertson Race of the Century between England and Australia Royal also competed in the Bendix Death Race in a Gee Bee Widow Maker Before World War II Royal worked for the Chinese warlord known as the Young Marshal who kidnapped Nationalist dictator Chiang Kai shek and changed the course of Chinese history Royal provided Communist political commissar Chou En lai his first plane ride and later served as Chiang Kai shek's personal pilot During the war Royal's roles were unique Claire Chennault chose him to

command the Flying Tigers Bomber Group Royal briefed Colonel Jimmy Doolittle on Chinese landing fields for the Tokyo Raid Royal Chennault and Madame Chiang Kai shek planned their own Tokyo bombing raid Royal survived flying the Skyway to Hell over the Hump for China National Aviation Corporation No wonder after a perilous flight war correspondent Martha Gellhorn described Royal as her hero Author s Biography The author has spent twenty years uncovering a rich trove of private documentary sources about the Forgotten Aviator Martin is a Phi Beta Kappa graduate of the College of William and Mary and has an M A in history from the University of Washington and a J D from the University of California Berkeley He is a retired Administrative Law Judge and resides in Sacramento California with his wife Carolyn
