

HOW TO WRITE A CRITICAL ESSAY



CRITICAL ESSAY OVERVIEW

- ▶ Critical essays involve doing an in-depth review and analysis of a particular topic or area
- ▶ Writing a critical essay often has the objective of unearthing the key underlying aspects of a topic
- ▶ Literature, plays and films, music, and visual and performance art all provide for critical essay topics



WRITING A CRITICAL ESSAY

- ▶ Work on the title of the essay in the event one has not been provided
- ▶ Write the name of the author or the creator behind what you are about to critique
- ▶ Write the purpose of the topic under critique as per your understanding
- ▶ Give the details on the publication data of the work that you want to critique
- ▶ Create an introduction that will feature your thesis and a summary of your analysis
- ▶ Write your thesis statement that will help to guide the writing that will follow
- ▶ Give an analysis of the work behind the topic. This involves the author's style and targeted audience
- ▶ Write on the efficacy of the work and wrap it up with a brief conclusion



GENERAL TIPS

- ▶ Research broadly on the work that you are critiquing. Research its creator, as well
- ▶ Use a previous critical essay example as a road-map when creating yours
- ▶ Infuse exciting facts about the work and ensure your opinion doesn't influence your analysis
- ▶ Double-check your work for reasons of rectifying mistakes and polishing its content
