

Persuasive Writing

What is an exposition?

An exposition is a piece of writing used to persuade or convince a reader of a writer's point of view or opinion. When we read these texts, we often see an argument being presented. The argument is either for or against a particular topic or theme. These types of texts are not used for entertainment. They are a persuasive type of text, and they are used to persuade or convince.

What is the structure of an exposition?

Title

This tells the reader exactly what the text is about. The title should be direct and to the point.

Introduction

The introduction should be clear and it should state your opinion. Your aim is to grab the reader's attention, and to make them want to read your argument.

1. Include a statement of position on what you believe about the topic. This statement of position should introduce the argument.
2. Provide a brief overview of the important points you will be presenting in your text. You may also want to give some background information about your topic.

Body

The body is a series of ordered and clear arguments. Each of your arguments will be presented in separate paragraphs.

1. Include a topic sentence at the beginning of each paragraph.
2. Organise your paragraphs using time sequence words like: firstly, secondly, furthermore, finally, to conclude.
3. Keep it clear, concise, and to the point. Do not add in any new information in that you did not highlight in your introduction.

Conclusion

The conclusion simply sums up your text in a powerful way. It is very similar to the structure of your introduction.

1. Restate your position as powerfully as possible.
2. Sum up your arguments and remember to not include any new information.
