

Group Therapy Guidelines

- 1. Maintain confidentiality-** I understand that everything said in group is confidential and must not be shared with anyone outside of the group. This includes the name and identity of group members and anything said while in attendance. Confidentiality is incredibly important for group dynamics and for creating and maintaining safety.
- 2. Attendance-** I understand that coming to group is a commitment, and I will work to prioritize weekly attendance. Being present on a weekly basis is key to therapeutic success for you and other group members. I agree to arrive on time, and if I am late, enter the room without disruption.
- 3. Participation-** I will work to be fully present and participate in group activities and discussions. However, I have the right to "pass" on a topic if I am not feeling safe or comfortable. I agree that will never pressure other group members to participate in any discussion or activity after the member has passed. I understand that the group leader is obliged to protect this right. I also understand that I will benefit more from group the more I am able to take risks in sharing and participating.
- 4. Relationships-** I agree to not have relationships with group members outside of group which includes dating or exclusive relationships. This can disrupt the cohesion and therapeutic process and cause additional harm or emotional distress. This includes texting, calling, or interacting on social media. If you do see a group member in public, please be sure to respect their confidentiality and share with the group at the next session that this occurred.
- 5. Drugs or Alcohol-** Group members cannot participate in the group under the influence of alcohol or other mind-altering drugs. When under the influence of chemicals, people do not have access to their emotions and have less control over their behavior. I understand that if the leader believes that I am under the influence of alcohol or other drugs, I will be asked to leave the group.
- 6. Gossip-** disagreements and conflict happens. However, I agree to not talk about other group members in a derogatory way and will address concerns or issues face-to-face with that group member. I will reach out for support from the group facilitator during this process if needed.
- 7. Respect-** I understand that the group facilitator is leading the group and may need to enforce these rules at times. I will respect their decisions and comply to all group guidelines.
- 8. Termination-** Depending on the type of group, group members may finish group at the same time, or at different times. At times a group member may have to leave unexpectedly. I will work to communicate if I plan to leave the group unexpectedly in order to maintain the therapeutic dynamics.
- 9. Additional rules-**

I have read the above guidelines and rules and agree to abide by them while participating in this group.
