By 1965 they had no pride, faced major economic and social issues such as unemployment, drug abuse, lived in poverty, had shum houses and they were not given equal opportunities like the white Americans. ✓

The Black Power Movement grew from the Black Power Philosophy. Black Power was an idea that aimed to instill a sense of self worth in African American and to encourage African Americans to become independent and proud of their heritage and culture. The Black Power Movement urged all African Americans not to rely on "hand outs" from the white Americans. The BPM also aimed to encourage African Americans to study their own history and to be proud of being Black. One of the major aims of the BPM was the promotion of black power, instilling black pride and encouraging self-respect among African Americans. ✓
