Writing an informational essay can be challenging, but knowing what to include in the introduction, body, and conclusion can help guide

simplify the process.

The first step in the process of writing an information essay involves the introduction. The most important part of the introduction is gaining the attention of the reader. Creating interest makes the reader more receptive to new ideas. After the attention grabber, the writer provides an EXPLANATION introduction of the main topic, including any background information the reader needs to understand the essay. The last sentence then includes the thesis statement, which identifies the purpose of the essay and can include the writer's supports. Upon completion of the introduction, the next step in the development of an essay includes the body paragraphs. TRANSITION

The purpose of the body paragraphs in an informational essay is to explain the major points

in support of the purpose statement. The first sentence of each paragraph should be a topic sentence identifying the main idea. The writer provides evidence to support that paragraph's specific topic. After identifying the evidence, the writer must explain how the evidence supports the claim identified in the topic sentence.
