Essential Question	How does air exert a force?
Learning Objectives	• TSW act out the motion of cool and warm air molecules. • TSW predict and observe the behavior of a balloon/bottle setup in warm and cool water. • TSW predict and observe the behavior of an egg/bottle setup. • TSW apply their understanding of air pressure to devise a means to remove an egg from a bottle. • TSW draw diagrams to represent their understanding of the phenomena they observe.
Other Objectives	• TSW engage in a discussion about air molecules and air pressure. • TSW communicate with the group to develop a cooperative environment.
