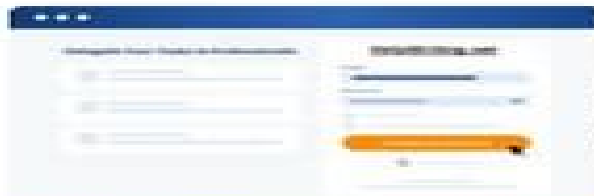

Essays on Diverse Topics Kalman Dubov, 2021-12-23 This revised and updated volume includes twenty two essays on timely topics The volume begins with topics on Judaism and Jewish Ideology the book reviews the multiplicity of languages Jewish people used throughout their history At last count these number 55 an amazing way to create a localized language for daily interaction rather than use Hebrew the sacred language reserved for prayer and study The brief review of Lurianic Kabbalah follows together with a discussion of human suffering The mystery of Ashkenazic Jewry follows offering a serious question to this dilemma What follows is an exposition on the Jewish law of mosur the informer and the many issues affecting sexual predation in ultra Orthodox Judaism both in the United States and Australia as in Israel The Cairo Genizah reviews how two Scottish sisters brought the Book of Ecclesiasticus to Cambridge and the vast treasure of Cairo brought to Cambridge and other universities to examine this ancient repository The issue of Apostate Rabbis follows discussing several rabbis who converted to Christianity I then discuss the Radhanites the mysterious group of super merchants who traveled from France to China and back for about 500 years centuries before Marco Polo I then discuss Chabad Messianism a topic of interest as Chabad expands its message across the globe Several topics follow Medieval Blood Libel the mystery of Jews in Sri Lanka today a minimal number but in earlier centuries numbering several thousand I then discuss several topics on the human condition essays designed to reflect on Man's ethical dilemma of life in the post World War Two era I then discuss the two original ideas regarding religion One of these is attributed to the Patriarch Abraham whose reflection on Deity and how to relate to spirituality predominates in the three great Western religions The other original thought is found in Hinduism reflecting an entirely different way to relate to Deity Because Hinduism is a Far Eastern phenomenon not readily accessible in the West I've included an overview of Hinduism so that the Western and Jewish views can be appreciated A new topic reflect on the Atrocity Soul and its counterpart reflecting of the Son of Darkness

and the Son of Light each bringing messages one of despair and darkness and the other of hope and redemption While these persons may be religious it is not a primary matter to the Son of Light but their message of hope predominates I conclude the book with a discussion on Calculating Zero an advancement only made twice in human history in the New World by the Maya and by the ancient Mesopotamians Each of the essays and reviews reflects my understanding of these and other diverse topics Each essay provides grist for discussion and reflection

Peculiar Attunements Roger Mathew Grant, 2020-03-03

Peculiar Attunements places the recent turn to affect into conversation with a parallel movement in European music theory of the eighteenth century During that time the affects or passions as they were also called formed a vital component of a mimetic model of the arts Eighteenth century critics held that artworks imitated or copied the natural world in order to produce copies of the affects in their beholders But music caused a problem for such theories since it wasn't apparent that musical tones could imitate anything with any dependability beyond the rare thunderclap or birdcall Struggling to articulate how it was that music managed to move its auditors without imitation certain theorists developed a new affect theory crafted especially for music postulating that music's physical materiality as sound vibrated the nerves of listeners and attuned them to the affects through sympathetic resonance This was a theory of affective attunement that bypassed the entire structure of representation offering a non discursive corporeal alternative It is a pendant to contemporary theories of affect and one from which they have much to learn Inflecting our current intellectual moment through eighteenth century music theory and aesthetics this book offers a reassessment of affect theory's common systems and processes It offers a new way of thinking through affect dialectically drawing attention to patterns and problems in affect theory that we have been given to repeating Finally taking a cue from eighteenth century theory it gives renewed attention to the objects that generate affects in subjects

Fanon, Žižek, and the Violence of Resistance Zahi Zalloua, 2025-06-26

In a novel pairing of anti colonial theorist Frantz Fanon with Marxist Lacanian philosopher Slavoj Žižek Zahi Zalloua explores the ways both thinkers expose the violence of political structures This inventive exploration advances an anti racist critique describing how ontology operates in a racial matrix to produce some human bodies that count and others deemed not quite or non human that do not For Fanon and Žižek the violence of ontology must be met with another form of violence a revolutionary violence that delegitimizes the logic of the symbolic order and troubles its collective fantasies Whereas Fanon begins his challenge to ontology by exposing its historical linkages to Europe's destructive imperialist procedures before proceeding to stretch Marxism along with psychoanalysis to account for the crushing neo colonial situation Žižek premises his work on the refusal to accept the totality of ontology Because of these different points of intervention Fanon and Žižek together offer a powerful and multifaceted assessment of the liberal anti racist paradigm whose propensity for identity politics and aversion to class struggle silence the cry of the dispossessed and foreclose radical change Avoiding contemporary separatist temptations decoloniality and Afropessimism and breaking with a non violent sentimentalist futurology that announces more of the same Fanon and Žižek point in a

different direction one that eschews identitarian thought in favor of a collective struggle for freedom and equality
