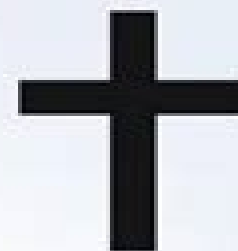

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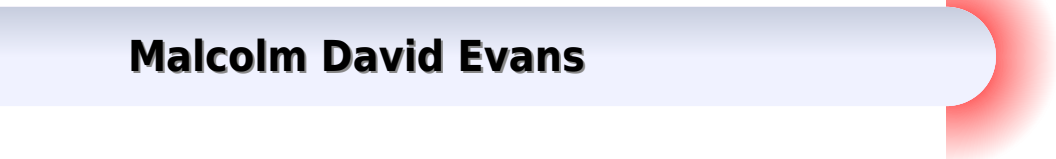

Religious Symbols and the Intervention of the Law Sylvie Bacquet, 2019-06-11 In contemporary pluralist states where faith communities live together different religious symbols and practices have to coexist This may lead to conflicts between certain minority practices and the dominant majority particularly around the manifestation of belief in the public domain which may be seen both by the religious and secular majorities as a threat to their cultural heritage or against the secular values of the host country The law has to mitigate those tensions in order to protect the public from harm and preserve order but in doing so it may where necessary have to limit citizens ability to freely manifest their religion It is those limitations that have been disputed in the courts on grounds of freedom of religion and belief Religious symbols are often at the heart of legal battles with courts called upon to consider the lawfulness of banning or restricting certain symbols or practices This book analyses the relationship between the state individuals and religious symbols considering the three main forms of religious expression symbols that believers wear on their body symbols in the public space such as religious edifices and rituals that believers perform as a manifestation of their faith The book looks comparatively at legal responses in England the U S A and France comparing different approaches to the issues of symbols in the public sphere and their interaction with the law The book considers religious manifestation as a social phenomenon taking a multidisciplinary approach to the question mixing elements of the anthropology history and sociology of religion in order to provide some context and examine how this could help inform the law

the public school classroom **Surviving Diversity** Jeff Spinner-Halev, 2000-05-22 6 The Public Squares *Reforming Mary* Beth Kreitzer, 2004-03-18 Catholics and Protestants have since the earliest days of the Reformation held markedly different views about the Virgin Mary In *Reforming Mary* Beth Kreitzer examines the development of Lutheran views on this subject as expressed in 16th century Lutheran published sermons starting with the earliest of Luther's own Reformation sermons She shows that from the beginning Lutherans rejected much of the theology and piety that surrounded Mary in Catholicism especially her status as heavenly queen and intercessor with Christ They affirmed those orthodox teachings about Mary that related to Christ the Virgin's role as Theotokos the virgin birth and by extension Mary's purity or perpetual virginity As time went on Lutheran preachers showed less interest in Mary as a topic and by the later part of the century showed an increasingly harsh and critical view of her These later sermons reveal a new willingness in opposition to received tradition to impute sin to Mary Kreitzer attributes this changed attitude to the increasing distance of Lutherans from their Catholic roots the logical results of theological changes in the Reformation and a perception of an increased threat of recatholicization Finally she shows Mary was pressed into service by preachers who endeavored to instruct the laity in both what to believe and how to live making a causal connection between being a good Christian and being a good citizen of society In this context Mary was used as a role model and was often promoted as an exemplar for females in ways that served to constrain and domesticate women placing them more firmly under male authority But despite the attempts by preachers to domesticate and mold her Kreitzer argues the Lutheran Mary remains a complex and paradoxical figure *Relating God and the Self* Jan-Olav Henriksen, 2016-04-08 Religion is not only about understanding the world it is just as much about how to develop and shape the self's experience of itself Because the religious self is shaped by our symbols of God and symbols of God are also shaped by the self theology and philosophy of religion cannot ignore this interplay or the psychological dimension when they discuss what symbols of God are adequate and not By discussing critically different ways the symbol of God functions in the formation of the self the book develops a nuanced and original approach to the interplay between God and the self It suggests that play is actually an important metaphor in order to develop a dynamic understanding of religion's way of relating God and the Self This approach challenges understandings of religion focussing only its cognitive claims as well as those who emphasize doctrinal orthodoxy as the most important element in religion **Wiley Blackwell Companion to Karl Barth** George Hunsinger, Keith L.
