Computer Science Department, 1998 Partial evaluators are compile time optimizers achieving performance improvements through a program modification technique called specialization Partial evaluators produce one or more copies or specializations of each procedure in a source program in the output program Specializations are distinguished by being optimized for invocation from call sites with different characteristics for example placing certain constraints on argument values Specializations are created by partially
