Coast Slave Rebellion to the 1971 Attica Prison Uprising from the truancy of enslaved women to the extreme self discipline exercised by prisoners in solitary confinement Black Americans have through time resisted racial regimes in extraordinary and everyday ways Though these acts of large and small scale resistance to slavery and incarceration are radical and transformative they have often gone unnoticed This book is about Black rebellion in captivity and the ways that many of the conventional well worn constructs of academic political theory render its political dimensions obscure and indiscernible While Hannah Arendt is an unlikely theorist to figure prominently in any discussion of Black politics her concepts of world and worldlessness offer an indispensable framework for articulating a theory of resistance to chattel and carceral captivity

Politics in Captivity begins by taking seriously the ways in which slavery and incarceration share important commonalities including historical continuity In Zuckerwise s account of this commonality the point of connection between enslaved and incarcerated people is not exploited labor but rather resistance The relations between the rebellions of both groups appear in the writings of Muhammed Ahmad Angela Davis George Jackson Ruchell Magee and Assata Shakur a genre Zuckerwise calls Black carceral political thought The insights of these thinkers and activists figure into Zuckerwise s analyses of largescale uprisings and quotidian practices of resistance which she conceives as acts of world building against conditions of forced worldlessness In a moment when a collective racial reckoning is underway when Critical Race Theory is a target of the Right when prison abolition has become more prominent in mainstream political discourse it is now more important than ever to look to historical and contemporary practices of resistance to white domination

Beyond the Sovereign Self Grant H. Kester,2023-11-17 In *Beyond the Sovereign Self* Grant H Kester continues the critique of aesthetic autonomy begun in *The Sovereign Self* showing how socially engaged art provides an alternative aesthetic with greater possibilities for critical practice Instead of grounding art in its distance from the social Kester shows how socially engaged art developed in conjunction with forms of social or political resistance encourages the creative capacity required for collective political transformation Among others Kester analyzes the work of conceptual artist Adrian Piper experimental practices associated with the *escrache* tradition in Argentina and indigenous Canadian artists such as Nadia Myre and Mich le Ta na Audette showing how socially engaged art catalyzes forms of resistance that operate beyond the institutional art world From the Americas and Europe to Iran and South Africa Kester presents a historical genealogy of recent engaged art practices rooted in a deep history of cultural production beginning with nineteenth century political struggles and continuing into contemporary anticolonial resistance and other social movements

A Continuous Struggle Garrett Felber,2025-05-06 The first biography of the revolutionary political prisoner who laid the foundation for contemporary abolitionist struggles and Black anarchism *A Continuous Struggle* is a political biography of one of the most important revolutionary figures of the twentieth century in the United States Martin Sostre 1923 2015 was a Black Puerto Rican from East Harlem who became a politicized prisoner and jailhouse lawyer winning cases in the early 1960s that helped secure the constitutional rights of incarcerated people He opened one of the country s first radical Black bookstores and was scapegoated and framed by police and the FBI following the Buffalo rebellion of 1967 He was sentenced by an all white jury to thirty one to forty one years Throughout his nine year imprisonment Sostre transformed himself and the revolutionary movements he was a part of eventually identifying as a revolutionary anarchist and laying the foundation for contemporary Black anarchism During that time he engaged in principled resistance to strip frisks for which he was beaten eleven times raising awareness about the routinized sexual assault of imprisoned people The decade long Free Martin Sostre movement was one of the greatest and most improbable defense campaign victories of the Black Power era alongside those to liberate Angela Davis and Huey
