that the meaning of the term in Shakespeare's time must be acquired as Shakespeare acquired it that is contextually Mr Soellner distinguishes three points in Shakespeare's evolution an early stage that culminates in the later histories and the romantic comedies in which the dramatist reflected sometimes almost schematically the humanistic patterns of his time a middle or interim phase that begins with Julius Caesar and includes both Hamlet and the problem comedies and in which Shakespeare experiences certain hesitations and entertains some doubts about the patterns accepted uncritically earlier and the final period of the great tragedies and tragicomic romances in which a growing awareness of the unpredictability of human nature leads to a dynamic synthesis in which what is the quintessence of humanism is fused with a full realization of the weakness of codification and a profound sympathy for the human condition In the last of his great plays the tempests Mr Soellner find Shakespeare composed a brilliant finale in which are worked many of the patterns that he used in his earlier work The dream of The Tempest that man can control himself limit his power and even resign it voluntarily is totally humanistic and may be utopia But it is one of the happiest expectations of man and represents an irresistible affirmation of his potential greatness Rolf Soellner

Patterns in the Production of Apulian Red-Figure Pottery Edward

Herring, 2018-10-01 Most of the previous scholarship on Apulian red figure pottery has focused on the cataloguing of collections the attribution of vases to painters and workshops iconographic and stylistic matters and individual vessels and vase forms This partly reflects the history of vase painting scholarship which grew out of antiquarian collecting during the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries and the fact that a full archaeological provenance is not preserved for the overwhelming majority of vessels This book takes a different approach by using a database containing in excess of 13 500 vessels and fragments to identify patterns in the production and decoration of Apulian vases that cast light on the choices made by vase producers and the preferences of their customers Individual chapters consider the popularity of different vessel shapes over time the use of highly generic decorative scenes which are characteristic of Apulian red figure as well as the popularity of scenes of myth images of the gods scenes of the life of the non Greek population of ancient Puglia and those showing funerary monuments As virtually all of the vases in the sample derive from tombs the patterns identified provide insights into the ways in which the ancient populations of South East Italy both Greek and indigenous honoured their dead

of Secularization Daphne Halikiopoulou, 2017-05-15 The politicization of religion is a central feature of the modern world pointing to the continued relevance of the secularization debate does modernization result in the decline of the social and political significance of religion or rather in a reaffirmation of religious values This book examines the emergence of different patterns of secularization It identifies the circumstances under which religion may remain or cease to be politically active and legitimate in societies where secularization has been initially inhibited given a strong identification with the nation Arguing that in such societies the Church draws its power not only from its relationship with the state but also its relationship with the nation this book identifies two patterns of secularization a co optation and b confrontation The

redefinition of the Church state and nation nexus is likely to result in secularization if a the church obstructs the modernisation process church and state and b if external threat perceptions decline church and nation The simultaneous presence of these constraints serves to redefine the role of religion in the formation of national identity Comparing Greece and the Republic of Ireland as two cultural defence cases with a strong variation in the political and social salience of religion this book explains Ireland s current secularization drive in terms of the fluidity of Irish national identity and the rigidity of the Irish Catholic Church confrontation It contrasts this with the Greek case where the Church s resilience is linked to institutional flexibility on the one hand and a reliance on an ethnic religious national identity on the other co optation In conceptualizing the contemporary role of religion in the Republic of Ireland and Greece this book draws a number of generalizable conclusions about the political role of religion in cultural defence cases **Gateway to the Heavens** Karen L. The thesis of A Gorgon s mask The Mother in Thomas Mann s Fiction depends upon three psychoanalytic concepts Freud s early work on the relationship between the infant and its mother and on the psychology of artistic creation Annie Reich s analysis of the grotesque comic sublimation and Edmund Bergler s analysis of writer s block Mann s crisis of sexual anxiety in late adolescence is presented as the defining moment for his entire artistic life In the throes of that crisis he included a sketch of a female as Gorgon in a book that would not escape his mother s notice But to defend himself from being overcome by the Gorgon mother s stare he employed the grotesque comic sublimation hiding the mother figure behind fictional characters physically attractive but psychologically repellent all the while couching his fiction in an ironic tone that evoked humor however lacking in humor the subtext might be In this manner he could deny to himself that the mother figure always lurked in his work and by that denial deny that he was a victim of oral regression For as Edmund Bergler argues the creative writer who acknowledges his oral dependency will inevitably succumb to writer s block Mann s late work reveals that his defense against the Gorgon is crumbling In Doctor Faustus Mann portrays Adrian Leverk hn as ultimately the victim of oral regression but the fact that Mann was able to compete the novel despite severe physical illness
