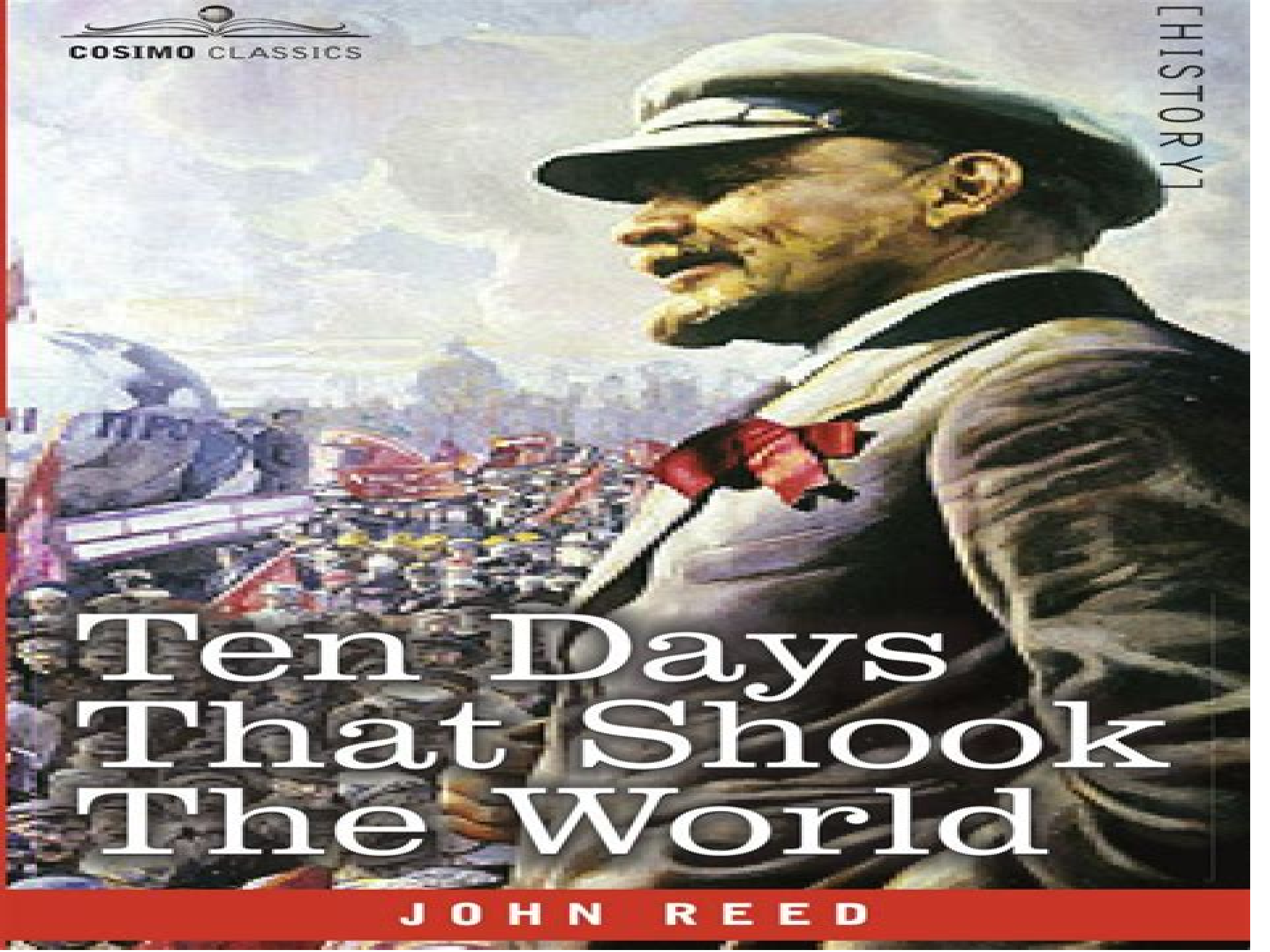

John Reed Kenneth Z.
