Ripper Suspect D J

Leighton, 2016-09-23 One of the most popular of all Ripper suspects Montague Druitt appears on the surface an unlikely killer Born into a comfortable bourgeois family he was educated at New College Oxford qualified for the Bar and played cricket for a number of strong club sides But there was another side to the agreeable Mr Druitt He moved in the artistic and aristocratic circles that overlapped with London's secretive homosexual culture was summarily dismissed from his post at a boys school and a few weeks later was found drowned in the Thames just months after the Jack the Ripper murders Six years later Chief Constable Sir Melville Macnaughten named Druitt as the murderer and gave the unhappy barrister a kind of immortality D J Leighton has dug deep into the background to Druitt's unhappy life and uncovered a web of intriguing connections linking the eldest son of the heir to the throne the Cambridge Apostles Sir Arthur Conan Doyle Virginia Woolf and the cricketing legend Prince Kumar Ranjitsinhji The book is a fascinating period piece that deftly weaves together the criminal sporting aristocratic and homosexual worlds of late nineteenth century London in search of the truth behind Macnaughten's surprising allegations This book is an excellent piece of period crime history with a Jack the Ripper setting It is a colourful Victorian underworld story mixing high society with scandal the golden age of amateur cricket and murder It is the authoritative debunking of the case for Druitt as Jack the Ripper

all of which are central to understanding Japanese teaching learning processes in schools *The Producer* ,1929 **The 1904 Anthropology Days and Olympic Games** Susan Brownell,2008-12-01 One of the more problematic sport spectacles in American history took place at the 1904 World s Fair in St Louis which included the third modern Olympic Games Associated with the Games was a curious event known as Anthropology Days organized by William J McGee and James Sullivan at that time the leading figures in American anthropology and sports respectively McGee recruited Natives who were participating in the fair s ethnic displays to compete in sports events with the scientific goal of measuring the physical prowess of savages as compared with civilized men This interdisciplinary collection of essays assesses the ideas about race imperialism and Western civilization manifested in the 1904 World s Fair and Olympic Games and shows how they are still relevant A turning point in both the history of the Olympics and the development of modern anthropology these games expressed the conflict between the Old World emphasis on culture and New World emphasis on utilitarianism Marked by Franz Boas s paper at the Scientific Congress the events in St Louis witnessed the beginning of the shift in anthropological research from nineteenth century evolutionary racial models to the cultural relativist paradigm that is now a cornerstone of modern American anthropology Racist pseudoscience nonetheless reappears to this day in the realm of sports North Korea Quarterly ,1995 *Promoting All-Round Education for Girls* Patricia P. K. Chiu,2020-06-02 Promoting All Round Education for Girls presents the history of Heep Yunn School one of the oldest girls schools in Hong Kong Amalgamated from two British mission schools founded in the 1880s for destitute girls and daughters of Christian parents and renamed Heep Yunn School in 1936 the institution has witnessed and responded to the dramatic changes of Hong Kong over the years By the time of the outbreak of the Second World War Heep Yunn had expanded to offer a full Chinese middle school course for girls based upon Christian principles of all round education The school expanded rapidly after the war and became a bilingual institution to meet the demand for English language education Eventually English would become the primary medium of instruction soon after the introduction of nine year universal education in 1978 Heep Yunn strives to provide a full fledged all round education in the midst of political and education reforms The school opted to switch its status from a government aided school to a direct subsidy scheme school in the early 2010s so as to retain a larger degree of autonomy This history of Heep Yunn School documents the concerted efforts of the school council staff students alumnae and parents to achieve the evolving visions of Christian education for girls as Hong Kong grew from a colonial trading port to a global financial centre in the twenty first century Promoting All Round Education for Girls convincingly charts the shifting purposes and practices of girls education in Hong Kong The text moves seamlessly between the history of the school and the wider context of Hong Kong s history Patricia P K Chiu illustrates how the school s educational policy evolved according to the wider strategies and shifts that relate models of femininity and nation building Joyce Goodman University of Winchester This solidly referenced work provides a balanced and detailed outlook on the unique evolving features of education in Hong Kong

Humans, Horses and Events Management Katherine Dashper,Guðrún Helgadóttir,Ingibjörg Sigurðardóttir,2021-03-12 Horses are perhaps the most common non human animal to feature in planned events but although there is considerable research on equestrian sport there is virtually none on equestrian events This book begins to address this gap using the National Championships of the Icelandic Horse as an extended case study to explain in depth the process of managing an event as well as the larger theoretical implications of events management Drawing on diverse viewpoints and theoretical perspectives the book draws wider comparisons to connect events management to larger themes in the social sciences such as human animal relations nationalism place branding event impacts event experience and inclusion and exclusion The book is a contribution to two fields In relation to human animal studies it focuses on how the Icelandic horse breed is marketed and celebrated through top tier competition whereas from an events management perspective it considers the role of the event in community building the practical and theoretical aspects of running a sustainable equestrian event and the issues that arise in multispecies event contexts
