**UNDERLINE
KEY WORDS**

- Underline the most important words
- Pick information that supports the main idea

**FIGURE OUT
THE MAIN
IDEA**

- Use key words to decide the author's big ideas
- Do this for each paragraph or section of the text

4

**WRITE THE
SUMMARY
(TAMS)**

- Use **TAMS**: Text, Action and About, Main ideas, Supporting details
- Use your own words
- Do NOT include your opinion
