Ethics and Suffering since the Holocaust Ingrid Anderson, 2016-05-26 For many the Holocaust made thinking about ethics in traditional ways impossible. It called into question the predominance of speculative ontology in Western thought and left many arguing that Western political, cultural, and philosophical inattention to universal ethics were both a cause and an effect of European civilization's collapse in the twentieth century. Emmanuel Levinas, Elie Wiesel, and Richard Rubenstein respond to this problem by insisting that ethics must be Western thought's first concern. Unlike previous thinkers, they locate humanity's source of universal ethical obligation in the temporal world of experience, where human suffering rather than metaphysics provides the ground for ethical engagement. All three thinkers contend that Judaism's key lesson is that our fellow human is our responsibility, and use Judaism to develop a contemporary ethics that could operate with or without God. *Ethics and Suffering since the Holocaust* explores selected works of Levinas, Wiesel, and Rubenstein for practical applications of their ethics, analyzing the role of suffering and examining the use each thinker makes of Jewish sources and the advantages and disadvantages of this use. Finally, it suggests how the work of Jewish thinkers living in the wake of the Holocaust can be of unique value to those interested in the problem of ethics in the twentieth and twenty-first centuries. that in order to understand those novels the readers need historical basic knowledge about the holocaust I assume that memoir authors use symbols and images that refer to the happenings without further explanation By doing this they leave more space for personal and emotional stories that cannot be found in pure fact based books or encyclopedias about the holocaust To get a full picture of the holocaust and understand the novels completely the reader needs to know the meaning of certain symbols for example chimneys or death marches In order to analyze this theory I am going to use historical literature as a reference point to see what events are neutrally described and taught as facts Then I will compare these facts to the novels *The Complete Maus* by Art Spiegelman and *Night* by Elie Wiesel to see whether they took time to explain the events more detailed or whether they just refer to a symbol or happening that would be counted as common knowledge First I will give an introduction to the novels to summarize their story and highlight peculiarities and differences In this part I will also give an overview over the historical literature that will be the basis for this paper In the second part I will highlight the most important facts symbols and images that are connected with holocaust events and recognized as general knowledge I will explain them shortly and present passages from the books that refer to these events In the end I will test my hypotheses and explain whether it has been proven as a true statement or not I will present my conclusion on the importance of memoirs and historical resources for a general overview on the topic of the Holocaust and NS regimes **Philological Papers**, 1999
