The goal is relevant to the universally positive objective of improving one's physical health.

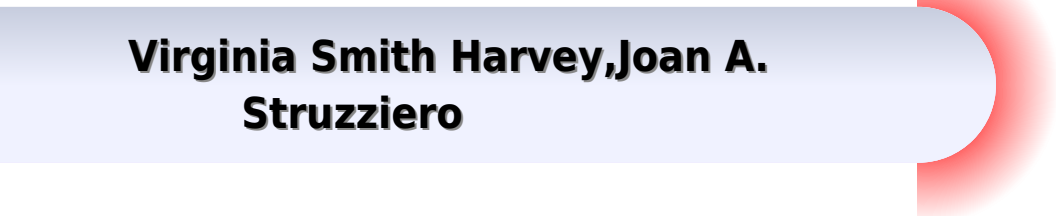


Time-bound
