

Zero Product Property

If $a \cdot b = 0$, then a and or b is equal to 0

Ex: Solve the following equation below.

$$0 = (x + 14)(6x + 1)$$

$$x + 14 = 0$$

$$6x + 1 = 0$$

$$6x = -1$$

$$x = -14$$

OR

$$x = -\frac{1}{6}$$

Would you rather solve the equation above or this:

$$0 = x^2 + 25x + 14 ?$$
