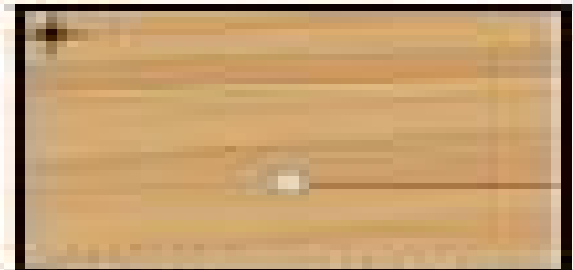

Magnetic Fields

Magnetic fields are created by moving electric charges and magnetic materials. These fields exert forces on other magnetic materials and can be used to generate electricity. In this lesson, we will explore the properties of magnetic fields and how they are created.

The magnetic field is a vector field, meaning it has both magnitude and direction. The direction of the field is indicated by the right-hand rule, which states that if you point your thumb in the direction of the current, your fingers will curl in the direction of the magnetic field.
