Labour and Economic Change in Southern Africa c.1900-2000 Rory Pilosof, Andrew Cohen, 2021-06-03 This book explores the social and economic development of Zimbabwe Zambia and Malawi over the course of the twentieth century These three countries have long shared and interconnected pasts All three were drawn into the British Empire at a similar time and the formation of the ill fated Federation of Rhodesia and Nyasaland formally linked these countries together for a decade in the mid twentieth century This formal political relationship created dynamics that resulted in yet closer economic and social links After Federation the economic realities of industry transport and labour supplies meant that these three countries continued to be intricately interconnected Yet despite these connected pasts comparative work on the economic histories of Malawi Zambia and Zimbabwe and how these change over time is rare This book addresses the gap by providing the first comprehensive collection of labour and census data across the twentieth century for these three countries The different economic models and performances of these states offer good comparison allowing researchers to look at different models of development and how these played out over the long term The book provides data on population growth and change industrial and occupational structure and the various shifts in what the economically active population did It will be useful for historians economists development studies scholars and non governmental organisations working on twentieth century and contemporary southern Africa

This book evaluates the development of the Rhodesian Air Force during the Second Chimurenga or Bush War, 1966-1980. Airpower in irregular conflict is effective at the tactical level because guerrilla warfare is not a purely military conflict. The Rhodesian Air Force was deployed in a war-winning versus a supporting role as a result of the shortage of manpower to deal with insurgency, and almost all units of the Rhodesian Security Forces depended on its tactical effectiveness. Technical challenges faced by the Air Force, combined with the rate of guerrilla infiltration and the misuse of airpower to bomb guerrilla bases in neighboring countries, largely negated the success of airpower.

The End of an Era? Robert Mugabe and a Conflicting Legacy Mawere Munyaradzi, Ngonidzashe Marongwe, 2018-09-17. Arguably one of the most polarising figures in modern times has been Robert Gabriel Mugabe, the

Extractive Industry Indigenisation in Zimbabwe Kennedy Manduna, 2025-09-25 This book explains how and why Zimbabwe's extractive industry Indigenisation over promised its benefits yet under delivered upon implementation This book traces the history of uneven development in Zimbabwe from the initial days of colonialism to the present using the extractive industry as the unit of analysis to carve out a granular and empirical analysis of the preponderance of transnational corporate control and ownership in the country Indigenisation of Zimbabwe's extractive industries was intended to address mining inequalities by transferring wealth from rich non Indigenous mining capital to disadvantaged Indigenous citizens and communities This policy however was a response to political economic and social crises posed by the international isolation of Zimbabwe's government following the controversial Fast Track Land Reform Programme in 2000 2003 An intervention therefore which promised to address inequalities has thus been hampered by corruption co optation and collusion which has led to it not only failing to address uneven development but in actual fact worsening the situation By examining the hidden structures and infrastructures of power capital and minerals and placing extractive industry Indigenisation in capitalism this book makes a crucial scholarly contribution to the renewed and burgeoning debates around the resurgence of resource nationalism in general and the struggle for economic sovereignty in particular This book steers readers more broadly to look for new and diversified ways of empowering Indigenous populations and their communities through mining Indigenisation in ways that do not threaten economic and political stability This book will be of great interest to students and scholars of the extractive industries natural resource management African politics and African development

Nhemachena, Artwell, Warikandwa, Tapiwa Victor, 2019-04-22 Tracing recent bouts of globalised Mugabephobia to Robert Mugabe's refusal to be neoimperially penetrated this book juxtaposes economic liberalisation with the mounting liberalisation of African orifices Reading land repossession and economic structural adjustment programmes together with what they call neoimperial structural adjustment of African orifices the authors argue that there has been liberalisation of African orifices in a context

COVID-19 Lockdowns and the Urban Poor in Harare,

Zimbabwe Johannes Itai Bhanye, Fortune Mangara, Abraham R. Matamanda, Lameck Kachena, 2023-12-09 This book focuses on the socio economic impacts of the COVID 19 pandemic and associated lockdowns on the welfare of the urban poor in the city of Harare Zimbabwe. The authors look through the lenses of the urban health penalty, the right to the city, complexity theory and distributive justice theory. These four theories help situate the COVID 19 pandemic and its impacts on the urban poor in the theoretical foundations that raise issues of how the poor are affected by disease health pandemics due to their living conditions. Uniquely, the authors use remote ethnography tools such as rich texts, video diaries and photo uploads to provide evidence-based stories of how COVID 19 mobility restrictions have affected poor urbanites in Harare. The book concludes that the COVID 19 pandemic mandatory lockdowns have deepened social and spatial inequality among the urban poor, threatening their right to the city. The socio economic impacts can upsurge poverty, increase unemployment and the risks of hunger and food insecurity, reinforce existing inequalities and break social harmony in the cities even past the COVID 19 pandemic period. These socioeconomic impacts must be considered to make just cities for all from a right to the city perspective. The authors recommend that mandatory COVID 19 lockdowns should not only be treated as a law and order operation but as a medical intervention to stem the spread of the virus, backed by measures to safeguard the livelihoods of the urban poor while also protecting the economy. This means governments should provide social safety nets to informal sector operators whose income-generating activities are affected the most during the time of emergencies like COVID 19. Planners and policymakers should re-envision pandemic resilient cities that are just, equitable, resilient and sustainable.

Remembering Colonialism in Zimbabwe Ivan Marowa, Ushehwedu Kufakurinani, 2023-12-14 This book examines the various ways in which colonialism in Zimbabwe is remembered, looking both at how people analyse, perceive and interpret the past and how they rewrite that past, elevating some players and their historical agency. Inspired by the ongoing movement on decoloniality, this book examines the ways in which generations of today question and challenge colonialism's legacies and their role in Zimbabwe's collective memories and history.
