

“To Kill a Mockingbird” is a Nelle Harper Lee’s novel that is believed to be one of the most outstanding classic of modern American fiction after its’ critical success as the best-seller of the 60-ies. The story was published in 1960 and gained a wide readership in consequence of life-critical issues took up at the heart of its’ storyline. It deals with true-to-life picture of racially tense times in Alabama, the writers’ home state. The book condemns racial injustice, portrays social prejudices that were present in America (eminently in Southern states) at that time, but that are still relevant in our legal system today, at once traces the role of education in upbringing the moral values of young generation, thus takes the reader to the womb of human behavior – cruelty and kindness, hatred and love, courage and cowardice. Harper Lee appeals for standing up for human rights and truth in spite of its’ price.

In the middle of the XX century America suffered a critical racial confrontation and prejudice among black and white people, especially are worth noticing three situations that may have affected Harper Lee in writing **“To Kill a Mockingbird”**. A black girl was arrested for her disobedience to a white man in public transport in 1955, the same year a fourteen-year-old black has been murdered violently for approaching a white woman in a shop. This provoked a series of boycotts which beared bad fruit in 1958 – a number of southern schools closed down due to their intolerance toward African-American people studying alongside whites. The infamous Scottsboro trials may also have provided a framework for the best-seller.

This novel is narrated by a six-year-old Scout Finch (a possible prototype of the writer herself) relates a story of an African-American man untruly inculpated in sexual assault of a white girl Mayella Ewell. Lees’ father, similar to Atticus Finch, the attorney in the novel, has defended a black man accused of rape who gets hanged and mutilated afterwards. These and many other similarities allow to draw a parallel between Lee’s own life experience and rueful feelings about her nations’
