immigration, but in a rightly controlled country, open immigration is not a viable option in the near fature.

These depopulated areas have tried to revitalize their economy through a variety of touthods. A reajority of villages choose the tourism industry as the tool to attract people to visit. For example, industrial heritage tourism was used in Yubari City in Hokkasko —a town that esperienced coultrine clessares. The "with local resort initiatives souring after the 1980s occurred bubble burst and cheap holdays abroad becoming more resultly available. Yubari's attraction fided." Even if Yubari tried to flather revitalize, burnewed capital as well as other struggling competing neighbor villages proved a difficult fature.

Kurmishi City located on the Sarriko Coast in Iwate Prefecture is a shrinking city with a strong past in the steel industry. Instead of opening attancement parks or relying on day visitors like Valuer, Kamaishi City has rediscovered itself through "green tourism." This green tourism involves a region's agricultural and fishery resources. In 1997, Kamaishi City enacted its green tourism plan with a variety of events advertising its local dishes and environment. Kamaishi City stanted its building blocks of revitalization through not depending on a single industry (steel), but also seeing tourism as an alternative. Unfortunately, the 2011 Great East Japon Earthquake and Trouwni would built any further developments in revitalization for Kamaishi City and many other disaster-affected areas in Tolloku Japon.
