In this six-step written and video recorded task, the candidate designs a standards-based lesson for a class of students and teaches that lesson to her/his students within the classroom setting, while making appropriate use of class time and instructional resources, meeting the differing needs of individual students within the class, managing instruction and interactions with and between students, and assessing student learning.

Following the lesson, the candidate demonstrates the ability to analyze the strengths and weaknesses of the lesson.

To promote reflective practice in teaching and to ensure equity to all candidates in the scoring of the task, a 20-minute unedited video of the lesson is made by the candidate and reviewed by the assessor.
