Mapping St. Petersburg Julie A. Buckler, 2018-06-05 Pushkin's palaces or Dostoevsky's slums

Many a modern day visitor to St Petersburg has one or more likely both of these images in mind when setting foot in this stage set like setting for some of the world's most treasured literary masterpieces What they overlook is the vast uncharted territory in between In *Mapping St Petersburg* Julie Buckler traces the evolution of Russia's onetime capital from a conceptual hierarchy to a living cultural system a topography expressed not only by the city's physical structures but also by the literary texts that have helped create it By favoring noncanonical works and underdescribed spaces Buckler seeks to revise the literary monumentalization of St Petersburg with Pushkin and Dostoevsky representing two traditional albeit opposing perspectives to offer an off center view of a richer less familiar urban landscape She views this grand city the product of Peter the Great's ambitious vision not only as a geographical entity but also as a network of genres that carries historical and cultural meaning We discover the busy messy middle ground of this hybrid city through an intricate web of descriptions in literary works nonfiction writings such as sketches feuilletons memoirs letters essays criticism and urban legends lore songs and social practices all of which add character and depth to this refurbished imperial city **The**

Praetorian Guard John Stockwell, 1991 Since its publication in 1991 this book has stayed in print although some parts may now be dated Stockwell examines often unjustified involvement of the CIA in many parts of the world through thousands of covert operations which have ended the lives of millions of people He describes secret and obscure operations some of which entailed the killing of people by the thousands at Angola and others such as the one which overthrew the first democratic government in Guatemala and the creation of the infamous death squads in that country and El Salvador to murder civilians and seed terror among the people *Russian Folk Art* Alison Hilton, 1995 *Russian Folk Art* surveys the traditions styles and functions of the many objects made by Russian peasant artists and artisans Placing the objects within the settings in which folk artists worked the peasant household the village and the local market Alison Hilton discusses the principal media artists employed and the items they produced from dippers and goblets to clothing and window frames Emphasizing the balance between time honored forms and techniques and the creativity of individual artists the book explores how images and designs helped to form a Russian esthetic identity in the 19th and 20th centuries Abundantly illustrated with examples from Russian museums *Russian Folk Art* is a treasure for anyone interested in Russian culture **Reagan's War Stories**
