Chapter I In the foregoing introductory sketch I have endeavored to present the influences to which George Eliot was subjected in her youth and the environment in which she grew up I am now able to begin the fulfilment of the promise on the titlepage that the life will be related in her own letters or rather in extracts from her own letters for no single letter is printed entire from the beginning to the end I have not succeeded in obtaining any between 6th January 1836 and 18th August 1838 but from the latter date the correspondence becomes regular and I have arranged it as a continuous narrative with the
