characters as slaves who are happy childishly reliant on their paternalistic masters and primitively agrarian. Such portrayals supported the so-called happy darkey caricature that was central to mid-century political ideology. Minstrels used this imagery to parody up and down social hierarchies, exploiting people of color and debasing opera's ostensibly elevated aesthetics. Alongside minstrelsy's racial politics, the parodies demonstrate creative musical adaptation. Each of the thirty-eight songs parodies opera differently, suggesting minstrels' inventiveness. The songs are rare and specific examples of the widespread practice of inter-genre borrowing and musical arrangement that was fundamental to minstrelsy.
