Memorandum by the Secretary of State to President Truman

WASHINGTON, [May 12, 1949.]

MEMORANDUM FOR THE PRESIDENT

Subject: The Wedemeyer Report on China²

For some time there has been a very deep interest on the part of various members of the Congress in the Wedemeyer Report on China. This has recently increased to the point where a decision should be made regarding the release of this Report.

The Report contains an independent and, in many respects, a realistic appraisal of the situation in China at the time of its preparation which might be advantageously placed before the American public. However, there are statements in the Report which, if released at this time, might have an undesirable effect abroad and others which would provide domestic critics of the Administration's policy toward China additional opportunities to attack that policy. The fact that most of the statements in the latter category are answerable probably would not prevent such attacks. Attached are (1) a copy of the Wedemeyer Report and (2) a memorandum analyzing the important portions of the Report.³

You will recall that the reason this Report was not released at the time of its submission to you was its recommendation that China request the United Nations to take immediate steps to bring about a

military engagement of the seven plus decades since World War II China between Peace and War highlights the contradictory role of political leaders who micromanaged the military including their struggle to connect political objectives and military power their rhetorical use of the decisive war concept and their pursuit of radical military political goals at the expense of a negotiated peace

War in the American Pacific and East Asia, 1941-1972 Hal M. Friedman, 2019-02-22 Before 1940 the Japanese empire stood as the greatest single threat to the American presence in the Pacific and East Asia To a lesser degree the formerly hegemonic colonial powers of Britain France and the Netherlands still controlled portions of the region At the same time subjugated peoples in East Asia and Southeast Asia struggled to throw off colonialism By the late 1930s the competition exploded into armed conflict Japan looked like the early victor but the United States eventually established itself as the hegemonic power in the Pacific Basin by 1945 Yet when it comes to the American movement out into the Pacific there is more to the story that has yet to be revealed In *War in the American Pacific and East Asia 1941-1972* editor Hal Friedman brings together nine essays that explore lesser known aspects and consequences of America's military expansion into the Pacific during and after World War II This study explores how the United States won the Pacific War against Japan and how it sought to secure that victory in the decades that followed ensure it never endured another Pearl Harbor style defeat and saw the Pacific fulfill a Manifest Destiny like role as an American frontier projected toward East Asia The collection explores the role of the US military in the Pacific Basin in different ways by presenting essays on interservice rivalry and military advising as well as unique topics that are new to military history such as the investigations of strategic communications military public relations institutional cultures of elite forces foodways and the military's interaction with the press Together these essays provide a path for historians to pursue groundbreaking areas of research about the Pacific and establish the Pacific War as the pivotal point in the twentieth century in the Pacific Basin

At Cross Purposes Richard C. Bush, 2015-02-12 Written by the former chairman and managing director of the American Institute in Taiwan this book sheds new light on key topics in the history of U S Taiwan relations It fills an important gap in our understanding of how the U S government addressed Taiwan and the Taiwan Strait issue from the early 1940s to the present One theme that runs through these essays is the series of obstacles erected that denied the people of Taiwan a say in shaping their own destiny Franklin Roosevelt chose to return Taiwan to mainland China for geopolitical reasons there was little pressure on the Kuomintang to reform its authoritarian rule until Congress got involved in the early 1980s Chiang Kai shek spurned American efforts in the 1960s to keep Taiwan in international organizations and behind the ROC's back the Nixon Carter and Reagan administrations negotiated agreements with the PRC that undermined Taiwan's position In addition to discussing how the United States reacted to key human rights cases from the 1940s to the 1980s the author also discusses the Bush and Clinton administrations efforts to preserve U S interests while accommodating new forces in the region All these episodes have an enduring relevance for the people of Taiwan and in his conclusion the author discusses where the relationship stands today

Jeans, 2017-11-27 When the Chinese Communists defeated the Chinese Nationalists and occupied the mainland in 1949 1950 U S policymakers were confronted with a dilemma Disgusted by the corruption and more importantly failure of Chiang Kai shek s Nationalist armies and party and repelled by the Communists revolutionary actions and violent class warfare in the early 1950s the U S government placed its hopes in a Chinese third force While the U S State Department reported on third forces the CIA launched a two prong effort to actively support these groups with money advisors and arms In Japan Okinawa and Saipan the agency trained third force troops at CIA bases The Chinese commander of these soldiers was former high ranking Nationalist General Cai Wenzhi He and his colleagues organized a political group the Free China Movement His troops received parachute training as well as other types of combat and intelligence instruction at agency bases Subsequently several missions were dispatched to Manchuria the Korean War was raging then and South China All were failures and the Chinese third force agents were killed or imprisoned With the end of the Korean War the Americans terminated this armed third force movement with the Nationalists on Taiwan taking in some of its soldiers while others moved to Hong Kong The Americans flew Cai to Washington where he took a job with the Department of Defense The second prong of the CIA s effort was in Hong Kong The agency financially supported and advised the creation of a third force organization called the Fighting League for Chinese Freedom and Democracy It also funded several third force periodicals Created in 1951 and 1952 in 1953 and 1954 the CIA ended its financial support As a consequence of this as well as factionalism within the group in 1954 the League collapsed and its leaders scattered to the four winds At the end even the term third force was discredited and replaced by new force Finally in the early 1950s the CIA backed as a third force candidate a Vietnamese general With his assassination in May 1955 however that effort also came to naught

Revolution

and War Stephen M. Walt, 2013-08-07 Revolution within a state almost invariably leads to intense security competition between states and often to war In Revolution and War Stephen M Walt explains why this is so and suggests how the risk of conflicts brought on by domestic upheaval might be reduced in the future In doing so he explores one of the basic questions of international relations What are the connections between domestic politics and foreign policy Walt begins by exposing the flaws in existing theories about the relationship between revolution and war Drawing on the theoretical literature about revolution and the realist perspective on international politics he argues that revolutions cause wars by altering the balance of threats between a revolutionary state and its rivals Each state sees the other as both a looming danger and a vulnerable adversary making war seem both necessary and attractive Walt traces the dynamics of this argument through detailed studies of the French Russian and Iranian revolutions and through briefer treatment of the American Mexican Turkish and Chinese cases He also considers the experience of the Soviet Union whose revolutionary transformation led to conflict within the former Soviet empire but not with the outside world An important refinement of realist approaches to international politics this book unites the study of revolution with scholarship on the causes of war
