Dunn, 2014-10-23 Steve R Dunn unravels the mystery of the First World Waw Rear Admiral Ernest **The Power and the Glory** Steve Dunn, 2021-01-30 The Power and the Glory tells the story of royal fleet reviews from the fifteenth century to the 2005 International Fleet Review commemorating the 200th anniversary of Trafalgar which was the final exhibition of that pomp and ceremony that had been an essential if irregular expression of naval strength for more than 500 years Whether to impress or deter a foreign power often when mobilizing for war provide reassurance for domestic consumption or celebrate a sovereign s accession royal naval reviews were an integral part of political positioning and national pride At these reviews particularly during the eras of British naval dominance potential allies or enemies were invited to marvel at British prowess while the British public could revel in the country's naval superiority advances in technology and ship design were showcased often for commercial benefit and homage paid to kings and gueens at the head of their fleets Starting with an examination of the reasons for Britain's need for and close association with a navy the author goes on to explain the historical political and technological context for British fleet reviews from the time of Edward III onwards The Royal Navy reached its apogee in the extended nineteenth century and The Power and the Glory examines this period in particular the aims and ambitions of the nineteen reviews during the reigns of Queen Victoria and King Edward VII and the subsequent twelve under George V Edward VIII and George VI After the Second World War and the Coronation Review of Queen Elizabeth II in 1953 the Royal Navy entered a long period of almost terminal decline which has been reflected in the lack of royal reviews since 2005 The book examines the reasons for this loss of what had been for centuries the main pillar of British power Finally the book looks at the history of the royal yachts used for conveying monarchs around their shores and fleets and how they reflected the character of the times Political manoeuvring technological change and the personal stories of many of the naval characters involved are all told with pace and verve as are the histories of many of the ships involved The Power and the Glory is a celebration of the Royal Navy and its role in our history and in particular of its essential importance to the pomp and glory of Britain's maritime heyday in the nineteenth and twentieth centuries

and submarines In his accompanying text Steve Dunn examines the ships themselves their design construction arming operations and development and he also relates how the trawlermen and skippers from the age old fishing ports of Grimsby Hull Lowestoft ad Great Yarmouth Aberdeen and Fleetwood came to be part of the Royal Navy and describes the roles they played the conditions they served under and the bravery they showed The book takes some 30 large sheets of drawings which John Lambert completed of these vessels and divides into two sections. The first part tells how the fishing fleet came to be an integral part of the Royal Navy s pre 1914 plans and details some of the activities and actions of trawlers and drifters at war in 1914 18 And the second investigates the armed fishing fleet in the struggle of 1939 45 These wonderfully detailed drawings which are backed by a selection of photographs and a detailed complementary text offer a superb technical archive for enthusiasts and ship modellers but the book also tells a fascinating story of the extraordinary contribution the vessels and their crews made to the defeat of Germany in two world wars The Petrol Navy Steve Dunn, 2023-07-30 On the outbreak of war in 1914 the Royal Navy found it required more small craft than it possessed to carry out minesweeping anti submarine patrols and coastal defense This led to the formation of an auxiliary force of civilian vessels including motor pleasure boats and yachts relatively new types of craft powered by the internal combustion engine The inclusion of these vessels came about when a group of motor boat owners suggested to the Admiralty that their vessels could play an important role in the defense of Britain The result was the formation of the Royal Naval Motor Boat Reserve RNMBR in 1912 By mid 1915 the demands of naval duty had proved too much for these quirky craft A meeting in the USA led to their replacement by American designed Elco motor launches MLs of which 550 were purchased and these Elco launches gave great service for the rest of the war usually officered by RNVR personnel who won three Victoria Crosses In addition to the Elcos in 1915 some naval officers developed the hydroplaning coastal motor boats CMBs which served with equal distinction in the latter part of the war Post war both types saw valuable service in the occupation of the Rhineland and in the Baltic campaign where three more VCs were won Other countries adopted similar craft In Italy the MAS torpedo motor craft achieved fame and success And in France MLs supplied by Britain and by Elco played their part Germany too utilized small motor vessels including the torpedo armed Luftschiffmotorboote and Fernlenkboot remotely controlled designs And when America entered the war she built a fleet of so called sub chasers wooden built and designed to counter U boats along her East Coast The Petrol Navy tells the stirring story of these motor driven boats at war of their development and operations and of the many colorful characters who were their captains and crew It will acquaint historians and enthusiasts with an important and previously untold aspect of the naval war and will engross those with a more general interest in the First World War Steam Yachts at War Steve Dunn, 2024-09-30 This is the story of how the luxurious steam yachts of the Victorian and Edwardian eras were transformed into weapons of war These beautiful vessels were the ultimate status symbols of British and European royalty American magnates the landed aristocracy and the nouveau riche but when wars came in 1898 and 1914 they were quickly
