The symposium examined crucial facets of chemical warfare from the first research on and deployment of chemical weapons in WWI to the development and use of chemical warfare during the century hence The focus was on scientific ethical legal and political issues of chemical weapons research and deployment including the issue of dual use as well as the ongoing effort to control the possession of chemical weapons and to ultimately achieve their elimination.
